### From The Rectory

#### Memorable moments!

A couple of years ago, I shared our experiences in Ho Chi Min city. Well, in mid April we once again headed for Saigon (as it is often called) but this time we were on an exciting 18 day tour of Vietnam, shared with five other people from the UK, Australia and New Zealand. We looked after each other, shared life stories, and became great friends.

From Saigon our tour included boating on the mighty Mekong River. The Mekong Delta is a densely populated area where life progresses around its fertile banks. We explored the Cai Rang floating market, weaving between traders and shoppers and mingled with the local people. From the water you see another side of Vietnam, witnessing incredible slums. But it is important to learn that the modern industrialised world has its edge, beyond which lies poverty and struggle.

We then flew to the coastal city of Nha Trang, which is home to a huge fishing industry. From there we cruised, in an old fishing boat, on the turquoise waters to one of the quiet Pacific islands for some relaxation. My paradise island!

Next, we flew to Danang and drove to Hoi An, which retains the feel of centuries past and is now a UNESCO World Heritage Site. There are lanterns everywhere and lots of people strolling up and down the alleyways and across footbridges. Everywhere the makers of street food are frying, roasting or boiling savoury scented dishes (the food in Vietnam is always fresh, delicious and beautifully presented). The iconic Japanese covered bridge, takes you across to an island where everything you'd just seen before is multiplied a hundredfold. We visited a workshop of traditional hand embroideries and saw the ladies at work making silk pictures and beautiful tablecloths. This workshop is part of a project called Reaching Out, providing opportunities for people with disabilities to learn skills and gain meaningful employment. These workshops are a platform for local people to showcase their talents.

We visited a farming project in a local village where the community has come together to create a large vegetable farm. I took my turn in doing a bit of raking and planting – equipped with Coolie hat and over-jacket in 32 degrees! Afterwards we were treated to a foot massage, and then helped cook our own lunch using the lovely herbs and vegetables from the farm – yummy and great fun!

Onward, to the ancient religious centre of My Son, a lesser known UNESCO listed site, set among lush green valleys, surrounded by hills and the massive Cat's Tooth Mountain. We walked through the bush (hot or what!) to the ancient religious centre built by the once thriving Champa Kingdom.

Our next stay was in Hue, driving over the dramatic and scenic Hai Van Pass and then cruising on the Perfume

River. The city is dominated by the Imperial Citadel that is modelled on the Forbidden City in China. There are 143 steps to the top of the main chamber at Khai Dinh tomb!

A flight took us to Vietnam's capital, Hanoi. The US bombing of Hanoi during the Vietnam War, caused massive damage. Hanoi has now been transformed into an industrial and agricultural centre. We had an exhilarating cyclo ride (amongst millions of motorbike riders!) through Hanoi's old quarter. We visited the Ethnology Museum with an extensive display dedicated to Vietnam's 54 minority peoples, giving us an insight into the heritage and diversity of the country.

We visited a family in Duong Lam village where we shared lunch and learned about village life. In the local Temple, there was a group of elderly women sitting and chatting together. One very elderly lady came over to us, full of smiles, and our guide interpreted what she was saying. She was delighted we were there and gave us a brief history of her life. Her wizened face was a picture of happiness, which has remained with me ever since.

Later, we saw a performance of the famous Water Puppets - invented thousands of years ago by farmers in the Red River Delta region as a means to entertain themselves when the rains flooded their paddy fields. Truly spectacular!

Next a cruise on Halong Bay, which shares a common border with China in the north and harbours some of the most stunning scenery in Vietnam. Unique rock sculptures jut out dramatically from the clear emerald waters and numerous grottoes have created an enchanting, timeless world, looking out onto the horizon, with the sails of the junks and sampans completing the picture. We visited underground caves (400 steps!) and watched the sunset over the bay. A memorable way to end our tour of this most fascinating, charming, friendly, and beautiful country.

Finally, Vietnam is officially an atheist state. But 70-80 percent practice Buddhism, Taoism and Confucianism. Christianity is on the rise (6-8 percent). Our young guide for North Vietnam confided that he followed Jesus. His wedding ceremony took place in his parents home three years ago. His Buddhist grandparents and relatives have disassociated themselves from him and his family. He strives for reconciliation, whilst firmly holding onto his beliefs. Along with his well deserved gratuity, I quoted two bible verses: *There is...one Lord, one faith, one baptism; one God and Father of all, who is over all and through all and in all.* (Ephesians 4:4-6). And 1 Corinthians 16:13-14: *Be on your guard; stand firm in the faith; be courageous; be strong. Do everything in love.* Encouraging words for us all!


Remembered a century on, a casualty of the Great War.



### North Tawton Town Council – election of Chair and Vice-Chair, and Co-option of new Member

At the Council's Annual meeting on 1st May, Councillor Steve Whiteley was re-elected as Chair of the Council for 2018-19. Councillor Ms. Jean Trewhitt was re-elected as Vice-Chair of the Council. Further to a vacancy on the Town Council, two residents applied to be considered for co-option to the Council. Mrs. Sue Weedon was the successful applicant, and will shortly be taking up her place on the Council.

### Dog Fouling – disposal of dog fouling bags

Thank you to all responsible dog owners who are doing their best to ensure our pavements and footpaths are safe and clean to walk along. We'd like to remind dog owners that it is your responsibility to clear up after your dog, and also to ask all dog owners to please dispose of the resulting used dog fouling bags – these bags can be placed in any litter bin, as well as in the specific dog waste bins, or carried home and placed in your domestic refuse sacks. Please don't run the risk of getting a penalty notice and a hefty fine, it's so easy to just take your dog waste bags to the nearest bin or take them home with you.

### Improvements to pavement - Station Road

I'm sure you will have noticed the fantastic job that the Council's contractors have done, in clearing the overgrowth on this pavement. The pathway has been widened considerably along some sections, weedkilling has been undertaken, and all the overgrowth removed and cleared around the bench on the corner of the junction. We hope this will make the pavement safer for our residents, and it certainly has improved the general appearance of the approach from De Bathe Cross. We're working hard to try and find a solution to provide better lighting on the length from Batheway Fields to the mini-roundabout, more news in due course. Finally, as the contractors finished these works in good time, they are undertaking a similar exercise at the bottom of Fore Street along to Yeo Lane, which will improve the appearance and safety of this length of pavement.

#### Finally, from the archives, 1972....

"The chairman explained the circumstances which led to the rather speedy purchase of a grass cutter. (There had been a demonstration of..a Haytor 1.6). It was the only model of its kind in stock and was approved for its performance by Councillor members with mechanical knowledge. Hesitation might have meant a further delay of weeks in obtaining a machine, and an urgent need to cut the lengthy grass decided the issue...."

### **Concert at Ashridge Court**

Last month's "Roundabout" asked readers to keep a note in their Diary of Sunday, 29th July, 2018 for an event in the Great Barn at Ashridge Court. By kind invitation of Chris and Carolyn Richards, the Bondleigh Barn Band will perform (appropriately) in the Great Barn at 3 p.m.. The performance will be appropriate also because it is hoped the efforts of the Bondleigh Barn Band will benefit St. James's Church in Bondleigh. During the considerable efforts made recently to improve facilities at the church, notice has been drawn to a remnant of mediaeval glass. It depicts the annunciation, the story of how the Angel Gabriel visited Mary to tell her she was to be the mother of Jesus - (you can find the account in St. Luke's Gospel, Chapter 1, verses 26 - 38).

As can be seen above, the picture is almost complete and this is something of a rarity. Wall paintings and windows showing stories from the bible were not to the liking of those who sought the Reformation of the church in the 16th century. Wall paintings were often covered over and windows taken out. In so doing, these pictorial aids to stories from the Bible were denied to a population in which many were unable to read. That any should remain at all in Bondleigh Church is probably because the glass is small in area and very high above the floor. It was perhaps too much bother for the removers to reach!

Despite the efforts of the weather in the past four hundred years, the glass has done well to appear as it does, but it is in need of some attention to help preserve it for future generations and the work to do this safely is likely to be expensive and require expert attention.

The Bondleigh Barn Band's concert is intended to make a start on raising money for the purpose. Admission to the concert will be FREE and there will be a retiring collection at the end to go towards the preservation costs. As ever, the band will play music you know, some you don't know and some in which you can join. We hope the band's wide repertoire will cater for all ages and that everyone will come along ready to relax, to enjoy themselves and help towards preserving a small part of the local heritage.

Please keep the date free in your diary!


#### An Extract from the Exeter Flying Post dated 5th August 1824:

A grand wrestling match for 10 sovereigns took place at North Tawton on Thursday and Friday last. So strongly was it contested and the balance of power so equal at 4 o'clock on the last day when no less than 16 laid claim to a share in the prize, and the skill and science displayed on both sides so equal, that it was left in doubt who should wear the laurel. After hard struggles till midnight, 1st prize was awarded to James Stone, 2nd to Robert Jackman, both of Colebrooke, and 3rd to William Smale of Monkokehampton. The play throughout was good and the enlivening band made the scene truly delightful. The good order and harmony throughout the whole arrangement reflects great credit on the managers who have resolved to renew this Grand National Exercise in the following year.

(This item was first printed in "Roundabout" in May 1992, supplied by Dr. Jean Shields who added this information:

"Wrestling took place on Court Green meadow (on the east side of the churchyard, the latter was enlarged and consecrated for burials in 1871, the wall built and a footpath leading from Court Green into the churchyard stopped up). It seems strange that people could spare two days from work at what must have been a busy time on farms."





### A local Parish Record

Many people have an interest in tracing their family tree and, providing you do not wish to go back beyond 1837 when registration of births, marriages and deaths was instituted, or 1841 when the first national census was introduced, you have a fair chance of success. Before then, you have to search in parish records and the going gets much less easy. Not all early records of baptisms, marriages and funerals are necessarily kept in the original parish. Some have been sent to the diocesan authorities or public record offices; some have been made available online and others not.

Another possible line of inquiry if you know the area where your forebears lived, is to go and comb the local church graveyard to find the headstone of a long dead relative. This has its difficulties: many graveyards are heavily overgrown and even memorials carved in stone can weather so that the lettering becomes unreadable. If there are those seeking forebears buried in the graveyard of St. Peter's Church, North Tawton,, the Vicar has a ready aid to hand. In 1992, three ladies, Celia Boughton, Kennedy Gregory and Jean Shields recorded the memorial inscriptions as well as the dedications of the church furniture in St. Peter's Church, the United Reform Church and the Methodist Church. It must have been an enormously time-consuming exercise, as they included the gravestones outside as well as tablets inside, and one result has been to preserve the wording discernible on the gravestones in 1992 from whatever further weathering may obscure or remove. The record included an index by surname of all those interred and a map of the graveyard showing the area where each grave may be found. This is a great time saver for the Vicar when he receives requests about burials in his churchyard from ancestor seekers. He can photocopy the relevant page and send it off. The frequency with which the same surname appears in the index gives a rough idea of the families who were resident during the period from the mid 1750's until around 1900, after which burials began in the cemetery in Exeter Street. Some of these families have left an enduring mark on the town today: Durant, Gostwyke, Letheren, Taylor. Others were possibly the ancestors of today's population: Avery, Bolt, Brealey, Gibbings, Lee, Luxton, Pike, Stoneman, Tucker, Ware.

And for those curious about such historical developments, there is interest too in other surnames. From much earlier times, surnames became attached to a man (and then settled on his descendants) because of his occupation: Ash, Hooper, Marchant, Seaward, Skinner, Taverner, Turner. Sometimes the surname might even suggest where the original owner lived, as in Coombe or Coombes and Moore. Was this the case for Catherine who died on 12<sup>th</sup> May 1831 aged 64, or her husband, Samuel, who died aged 94 years on 28<sup>th</sup> October 1850, whose surname was Honeychurch?

Whatever interest you may have in matters of this kind (or not!), this article is a belated opportunity to acknowledge the work done by the three ladies to keep records for the town and to thank them for the long labour they must have had to complete their task.

(We are sorry to learn of the passing of Dr. Jean Shields. As shown in the article here and on page 13, her long and active interest in history generally and in the history of North Tawton in particular, will be sadly missed – Editors)




