

From The Rectory

Christmas... enjoying the build up?

"Christmas... I think I enjoy the build up more than the actual event." I caught myself saying that to someone recently. They looked at me a little shocked. But on reflection, I think I hesitantly stand by my comment. Perhaps I should choose whom I say it to more carefully. However, my hunch is that I'm not alone in thinking this. As we draw close to the end of November, justifiably decorations start to appear outside houses and pre-Christmas events begin to fill the diary. I love it. Any earlier than about 20th November and it doesn't feel quite right, but once the seal has been broken and the first mince pie has been consumed, I really enjoy the festive build up throughout Advent to Christmas Eve. I'm sure it has something to do with having children in the house. As their excitement builds, so does mine. Oddly, though, by the time we get to Christmas morning I usually sense that the wave of expectation has already broken.

People often say to me in late November... "Coming up to your busy time of year again Vicar." If I could have a penny for every time I heard that, Mrs Weldon would get an even bigger Christmas present. "True," I reply, "but some regular things in the diary do stop for Christmas," I usually add. December is a busy time for me from a work point of view but probably not a lot more than any other month of the year. I think it is family life in the run-up to Christmas that makes life much busier, and that is the same for any family, not just a Rectory family. Also, I am fortunate enough to actually enjoy my job, mostly, so when the carol services begin to come thick and fast, generally I relish the challenge.

I think I've now put my finger on why I enjoy the build up to Christmas more than the actual event. During the pre-Christmas run in, especially the few days running up to Christmas Eve, the truths of Christmas are most apparent. This is when we all sing the carols and hear the story of the Child in the manger. By lunchtime on Christmas Day, most of us are elbow deep in food, family and wrapping paper. It's no different in our household. Frankly like anybody, by 1pm on Christmas Day, I either want to be sat on the sofa with a glass of wine, or sat in the car on an empty A303 trying to beat our record journey time to the grandparents in Surrey (3hrs 10 mins – Christmas Day 2013); wine on arrival!

Technically speaking, Christmas starts at midnight on Christmas Eve, of course. But sometimes the obvious needs to be re-stated when the obvious has become blurred. Everything up until the moment the clock strikes

half-way through the Midnight Service is either Christmas Eve or Advent. 00:01 on 25th December is the first minute of the first day of the Twelve Days of Christmas. Indeed, some churches even here in Devon, do their carol service on either 27th December or on the first Sunday of Christmas. This is technically correct, if a bit impractical. Commonly, we would think this was "after Christmas". In fact, it is mid Christmas.

Personally, I'm quite happy to do as most people do and most churches do, which is have our carol services and Christmas events throughout December in the build up to Christmas Day. I think this makes more sense practically. It is the time when people want to come out and join with others in the community before they baton down the hatches with family for a few days from Christmas Day onwards.

But I'm happy to do Christmas before Christmas for another reason too. The truths of Christmas are true any day. I'll sing "Hark the herald" in June if I could. I'll wonder at "God coming as man" any time of the year. "Christ the new-born King" is just as true on mid-summer's day as it is half way through the Midnight Service on a chilly Christmas night. It's the story that thrills in the end, or at least it should. That's not to say annual remembrances at certain points in the year are not important; the moment matters. I'd be a bit miffed if my wife said to me on my birthday, "of course Nick, you were just as alive last week as you are today. So that car sponge I got you last week from Mole Avon — that was your present." Cheers!

The point is this: it is the wonder of Jesus that matters most throughout the Christmas period. Before an all-consuming family Christmas kicks in, He deserves a little of our attention, and the build-up to Christmas might be the best time for that. Maybe that moment will come for you whilst watching a Nativity play, or hearing carol singers in the street; better still, singing carols yourself at a carol service? (Details of all carol services and Christmas events across the community are in this issue on page 17). For me, though, nothing beats carefully considering again the Bible's account of angels, shepherds, and the Saviour who is Christ the Lord. That's not the build up. That's the main event. If the Christ of Christmas comes to me on 21st December, it's no problem that He's come early. He has come, and that is all that really matters any day of the year.



Remembered a century on, casualties of the Great War.

Gunner William Brock of the Royal Garrison Artillery aged 22 years.

He died on 20th December 1918 in Giesson Prisoner of war camp and is buried in Niederzwehren Cemetery. He lived in Lakeway, North Tawton.



(Although the Armistice came into force in November 1918, casualties of the war continued being recorded into the following year. We shall mark four more from 1919 and they will be a sad reminder that the end of the war was not an end of suffering. Many who returned carried physical and mental scars for the rest of their lives.)

These machines are very user friendly, but nevertheless it is well worth undertaking the training to give you confidence if you ever have to use one of these machines – more and more are being installed in public places.

North Tawton Afternoon W.I.

Ramblings of a North Tawton W.I. Member

So who else thinks of soap on a rope when remembering Christmas past? – okay, just me then. It used to be Pretty Peach hand cream for mum and soap on a rope for dad. With liquorice allsorts, crystallised orange and lemon slices and a box of Lings rose Turkish delight. Christmas? – tick, DONE! And whilst I'm wittering away about Christmas did anyone else have a 'Tunis' cake on their Christmas tea table? So very 1970's.

More festive ramblings later if you're good. Let's talk about R.A.P.I.D. UK – or rather relate some of the incredible experiences of our November speaker Graham Payne, who has been associated with this organisation since its inception in 1988. With it's initials standing for 'Rescue And Preparedness In Disasters' it's aim is to respond to global crises such as the aftermath of hurricanes, earthquakes and severe flooding by sending trained search and rescue teams. The 'Preparedness' refers to training U.K and international communities to be able to respond to and cope with disasters when they occur. All of the team members are volunteers and could be from the military or the Fire, Police and Ambulance services, together with engineers and builders who have all been put through 18 months of R.A.P.I.D. training before they can be deployed within hours of a disaster, anywhere in the world, with the sole aim of saving lives.

Graham had brought a selection of slides which gave more than a flavour of some of the rescue missions in which he has been involved. Pictures of the teams attempting to locate and rescue people trapped in all types of buildings which have collapsed following an earthquake, were followed by pictures of landscapes completely flooded. Graham explained that the way a building falls can make a huge difference to the survival chances of people inside. If it 'pancakes' or collapses straight down on itself the likelihood of finding people alive is far lower than if the same building were to skew sideways as this could create 'voids' in the debris where people may be trapped but eventually rescued. He went on to describe the use of carbon dioxide detector probes – a hole is made in the debris and the probe lowered into the building - if the levels of carbon dioxide are increasing this could indicate that people may well be trapped within. Sound locating equipment and search and rescue dogs are also vital to the team. Graham's talk brought forward a lot of questions from the ladies – good indication of a gripping and very interesting subject.

So now our W.I. can add two more skills to its CV – cheesemaking [following a superb tour of Taw Valley Creamery] and beermaking [after an excellent tour of Taw Valley Brewery]. Husband says he is happy to share some of his skills with us – how about learning to rotovate your veg patch and do a bit of 'scuffling' [translation for scuffling – move the soil about a bit], or he could demonstrate how to turn around a worn collar on a shirt – seriously, he can do it – I've watched him and then gone to Mole Avon to buy him a new shirt. He also has a wooden darning mushroom and YES,

he knows what to do with it.

Our Pint and Pasty Quiz Night is looming, our 90th Birthday Lunch is on the horizon and our Christmas Party is just around the corner and you know what that means - "oh, okay – I'll have another mince pie if I must" and "no – I don't mind having it with that much cream" and "if nobody wants these left over mince pies I suppose I could take them home and give them to husband". Did I say give them to husband? I know Christmas is supposed to be a time for giving but really??

One of my favourite pre-Christmas games is try to guess which house in North Tawton will be the first to have a Christmas tree up in their window, closely followed by who will be the first to shout out 'OH NO – the fairy lights have stopped working'. Happy Easter.
