#### From The Rectory

#### Learning a lesson from my children

As any parent or grand-parent knows, children are great teachers. I've learnt so much from our three children in the last 10 years since the first one appeared. I thought I knew quite a lot about life and the world, and I was looking forward to steadily downloading all my "great" wisdom to my beloved offspring. But in fact, it's been as much about them teaching me as me teaching them. How did I get this far without knowing my phonics? "A... A... Ants on my Arm... causing me Alarm." There is a world of mini-beasts out there that had somehow passed me by for the first 32 years of my life. I now know the difference between a cartwheel and a round-off. I can't do either of them, and nor should I try, or else it might lead to a visit to A & E. (In case you hadn't worked it out, I am led to believe they are gymnastics moves.) As for the Terrible Tudors, the Next Step and Operation Ouch!... if only these and Daddy Pig had been around in the 1980's, just think what I could have become.

This year, mainly due to the passion and knowledge of my middle child, I have now become an eco-warrior. Well, that might be slightly overstating it. Perhaps I've just become a slightly better steward of my little patch of the world's resources, as I have yet to chain myself to the check-in desk at Exeter Airport, and I still quite like my diesel VW. But the passion with which I am now recycling all plastic packaging is maybe my mini Extinction Rebellion.

Jane and I have been really challenged by our children's passion for the planet, and necessarily so, for they could be on it for another 100 years. Samuel will talk at length about his concern for global warming. Emily has revolutionised the Rectory waste management system, and even Livvy will now put her used yoghurt pots in the "stinky green box" rather than the "big red bin." The older two's school science books read like Greenpeace propaganda pamphlets, and we have found ourselves more and more tuned into the subject according to Psalm 139. And part of God's design for us is on TV and online.

Here's just one of the effects in our household of taking our concern for Creation a little more seriously. Every other Wednesday evening when I take out the big black bags of rubbish, what used to be four full bags is now only two. At the risk of environmental virtue signalling (and there's a lot of that around!) the difference is that for the last few months we have been taking all our plastic packaging to the recycling centre in Okehampton. (I do hope it actually gets recycled!) And we're trying much harder to avoid single use plastic altogether. Perhaps you have been doing this for years, or you've been using the monthly plastic waste collection here in North Tawton on the third Saturday of every month. But we feel we are at least beginning to make a much better contribution to this present day global

challenge of reducing plastic waste.

I remain a little sceptical about some of the wilder claims of the environmental doom-merchants, and the rhetoric we are fed these days can sometimes seem a little over-the-top and all-pervading. But mainly at the instigation of our children, we've been challenged to think a lot more deeply and practically about this matter as a family in recent months. To this end, I am now more convinced than ever of our responsibility to be good stewards of God's Creation.

Most Christians have quite a clear theology of Creation, and I would argue that in a rural community like ours, that sense of care for creation extends well beyond those who go to church or profess faith in Christ. We all look out of the window and see rolling fields and livestock, and many will praise God. But perhaps we have not taken our personal practical stewardship of the world's resources seriously enough. So one minute we are praising God for the harvest and the next we are driving home in a gas-guzzler for a hearty top-side of beef. Personally, I look forward to one day owning an affordable and properly practical electric vehicle. As every month goes by there seems to be more and more of them around. As for reducing my red meat consumption though, well, I might, a bit, - smaller and more locally sourced rump steaks from now on.

There seems a lot that is very new and very pressing about environmentalism. Sometimes the message comes across as alarmist and shrill, especially on TV documentaries. But actually the challenge of good stewardship is as old as the hills, and when we care for Creation we are engaging in an activity that should come naturally as human beings. The Christian understanding of humanity is that we are soul, spirit and body. We have no enduring existence apart from our bodies. We are fearfully and wonderfully made, that we need food, water and oxygen, without which we can only survive for a few weeks, a few days, and a few minutes respectively. Of course, these all come from the world that God has made and in which human beings are placed as stewards. So why should I do nothing less than look after this wonderful world to the best of my ability? I think I might be learning my lesson. Maybe we all need to.



#### Road Closures.

Devon Highways will be undertaking summer patching work on the B3125 between North Tawton and Okehampton from late July and into August. The official diversion will route traffic via Whiddon Down and the A3126, as the regulations require diversions to accommodate a safe route for HGV's. Local car users will doubtless be aware of shorter, alternative routes. The nature of the work will mean that not all of the road will be closed all the time, but it will be advisable for anyone making journeys to and from Okehampton during this period to allow for re-routing and extra travelling time.

#### Councillor Vacancies

The Council has received three applications in response to its advertisement to fill the two vacancies on the Council. The Council will consider the applications at its August meeting.

#### Art Installation

Work is progressing well on the art installation to be erected on the corner of Moor View and High Street. The local artisans met Councillors on site in June and a wooden "mock-up" provided an opportunity for last-minute refinements. The steel structure will be mounted on weathered granite sets and we are looking forward to seeing the final realisation of this project.

#### Manshed

Although the Council has received some feedback with regard to this initiative, there is a need for further local support to enable an independent group to be set up to manage the project in partnership with the Town Council. The initiative will provide opportunities for social connections and building friendships. It also facilitates skill sharing and knowledge and hopefully will also utilise the old Chapel of Rest building. If you are interested in helping to run this venture, please contact the Town Clerk.

#### Annual Audit.

The Council will have fulfilled its audit obligations to make the 2018/19 accounts available for public scrutiny by 26<sup>th</sup> July and the external audit, undertaken by our auditors, PKF Littlejohn LLB, will progress to its next stage. Please note that the Open Access legislation encourages public attendance at Council meetings – the agendas are always displayed on the Notice Board and on the council website. The next meeting is on 6<sup>th</sup> August at 7.30pm at the Council office.

#### Ramblings of a North Tawton W.I. Member

Call him old fashioned (I frequently do) but husband can never remember exactly what an 'Americano' or a 'Mochachocachino' is. There we are, perusing a menu and I'm wondering how long it will be before I hear him say "why do they have to make it so complicated?" So when I saw the following, I was convinced it had been written solely for him.

Brilliant. So we'll have a pot of Not Coffee for two please.

Vicki Mills works for Waitrose, she is a 'Community Matters Champion'; she is also a 'Dementia Friends Champion' and she loves talking to people. Vicki wants to spread the word about the Dementia Friends Programme and we were very happy to be on the receiving end of her infectious enthusiasm for the subject. The Alzheimer's Society's Dementia Friends Programme is the biggest ever initiative to change people's perceptions of dementia and it aims to transform the way the nation thinks, acts and talks about the condition. A Dementia Friend is someone who learns about dementia in order to help their community by raising awareness and understanding, – this can then help and support people living with dementia to continue to live in the way they want. Vicki explained that sometimes people are reluctant to get a diagnosis as society's view tends to be that dementia is, understandably, 'scary and confusing' – however, as she went on to tell us, we can all make little changes which could have a huge impact – good communication skills are really valuable – making sure you smile, speak at a slower pace and give someone plenty of time to respond. Use lots of eye contact and encouragement during a conversation and move away from any distractions if possible. These little things may seem obvious but to a person with dementia they can really make a difference.

At the beginning of the session Vicki stated that one of her aims was to get people talking about dementia – and it was pretty clear by the end of her talk that she had achieved exactly that. Time for 'Not Coffee' and the chance to sign up for outings, eatings (new addition to W.I. dictionary) and BUNTING. Yes – MORE bunting. A bunting workshop. At Hilary's. Where President Jan and I will be on hand to make coffee and not coffee and if we're really, really good Jan and I may be allowed to cut out triangles of material. We will look longingly at the Harley Davidson style sewing machines and the beautifully neat double sided, perfectly stitched bunting appearing in front of us and ask ourselves why didn't we pay more attention in handicraft classes at school? My report card from Miss Davis always said 'Susan tries hard but results vary'. And mum said she was being kind.

## OKEHAMPTON AND DISTRICT LOCAL HISTORY THE JEAN SHIELDS MEMORIAL DAY SATURDAY 10th AUGUST 2019 at 2 p.m. St. Peter's Church, North Tawton

This public event will describe the important archaeological work that is going on in our area with particular reference to the Roman remains.

Local archaeologist Steve Stocker will give a talk entitled "In Search of a Roman Road "describing his researches into the route of the ancient road from Crediton to Okehampton.

The Archaeological work of The University of Exeter will be represented by Chris Smart who has a wide knowledge of the Roman Forts in Devon and Joao Fonte who is experienced in modern archaeological methods and has a wide knowledge of the Roman Military. They will describe geophysical work and excavations that are under way at local sites. This will also describe work going on in other parts of West Devon.

After the talks there will be an opportunity, by kind permission of Mr. Nigel Dunn, to visit the site of the Roman Forts which are on private land. Instructions for driving to the site will be given at the meeting. Visiting the sites will involve a walk of about half a mile. There may be some mud so please have appropriate footwear available.

It may be possible to arrange a walking visit to parts of the Roman Road at a later date.

Okehampton and District Local History Society is grateful to Rev'd Nick Weldon for the use of St. Peter's Church. This meeting commemorates the work of Dr. Jean Shields B.E.M. who did so much for the encouragement of the study of the history of our area. She lived at de Bathe cross and knew the Roman sites well.

There will be a charge of £4 per person for the talks and visit which includes temporary membership of the History Society.

The Roman occupation of Britain lasted from about AD 50 until AD 450. At several different periods during that time North Tawton was the site of important military bases probably guarding the crossing of the River Taw on the road which led through Exeter and Okehampton towards Cornwall. Some of these military camps would have had thousands of troops present with accompanying buildings for family and civilian workers.

#### HIGH STREET WANTS TO BECOME GREEN STREET!

Residents of High Street got together recently and representatives of several households discussed ways of improving life in their immediate neighbourhood. Socialising was high on the agenda, with a cheese and wine evening now being planned, but there were some topical issues that concerned the group as a whole.

Some residents had been following Hugh Fearnley-Whittingstall's TV series 'War on Plastic' which highlighted the damage being done to the environment by the use of plastic. As a response, the group decided that it wanted to take some action - however small – towards High Street becoming 'greener' street. The programme has featured a street in Bristol where residents are actively trying to improve their environmental footprint.

A first action has been to write to West Devon Borough Council asking for details of what happens to the waste we put out or collect for recycling. Future action may include new recycling initiatives and finding alternatives to single-use plastics. We will share any ideas with the rest of the town.

Two representatives from the street were nominated to the Town Council's Transport and Parking Group in response to concerns about vehicles speeding in High Street and to tackle the parking crisis.

The group is to form an unincorporated association as Friends of High Street – membership open to anyone who lives in High Street - and its Facebook page is under construction: **Friends of High Street Group.** You can message us through that page, and we'll later have our own email address. Watch this space.
