

From The Rectory

Warning - rant alert!

After three years of nauseating governmental deadlock, we now have to endure a second act in the lengthy political pantomime that started with that blessed referendum in June 2016. First the Brexit stalemate, now a Conservative Party leadership contest. Ahhhh! When will it end? Please make it stop! And we haven't even left the European Union yet! And as if things couldn't get any worse, the Government has just shelved the plan to widen the A303!? No! Seven hours from here to Guildford it took me a couple of weeks ago! I've got an idea... use the over 75's TV licence money to build an extra lane past Stonehenge! Please Boris? Please Michael? Please Jeremy? whichever of you will be Prime Minister next. Please make it happen!?

Okay – rant over. (It was quite a short one!). I'm sure I'm not the only one showing significant signs of political fatigue. It's exasperating, exhausting - like watching a Brit clinging on for dear life in a fourth set tie-break at Wimbledon.

Trying to be more constructive for a moment, whether we like it or not, there is now a contest going on for the next leader of the Conservative Party, which will, under the current slightly odd system, make the winner our next Prime Minister. There is long tradition in the Christian faith of praying for and submitting to those in authority, be they leaders in the church or heads of state. It comes from the Apostle Paul's instructions to the believers in Rome (Romans chapter 13) that God has established all authorities, so people should respect them and not subvert them. It is an extension of Jesus' teaching when he famously said his followers should "give to Caesar what is Caesar's and give to God what is God's" (Luke chapter 20). So exasperated as I am (and perhaps you are too) I take it, therefore, that we should always seek to engage positively in local and national politics no matter what the situation is. And spare a thought also for the numerous sovereign states whose political crises are far deeper and more deadly than ours.... e.g. South Sudan and Yemen to name but two of the most obvious.

I suppose what would be most heartening to see as the leadership contest progresses is someone rising to the top with the character, integrity, ingenuity and determination to take the country forward constructively in this challenging time; someone who I'm not holding my breath. At the time of writing there are seven names still in the hat, and by all accounts there is a clear front-runner. So far, the various self-promoting pitches that each candidate has made has reminded me of the legendary and perhaps imaginary figure "Hugh Gallagher", except

none is as articulate and funny as him. Mr Gallagher may exist, he may not, but legend has it in 1998 this mysterious young man applied for a place at a university in New York. When asked in his application form if he wanted to say anything further to help with his application, he wrote ... "I am a dynamic figure, often seen scaling walls and crushing ice.... I write award-winning operas. I manage time efficiently.

Occasionally, I tread water for three days in a row.... I woo women with my sensuous and godlike trombone playing... I cook Thirty-Minute Brownies in twenty minutes. I am an expert with Polyfilla, a veteran in love, and an outlaw in Peru.... I have won bullfights in San Juan, cliff-diving competitions in Sri Lanka, and spelling competitions at the Kremlin. I have played Hamlet, I have performed open-heart surgery, and I have spoken with Elvis.... Next week I will be 18." I love this guy. Even if he doesn't exist, whoever wrote this piece that now circulates the internet in various forms would make an excellent Prime Minister. He'd widen the A303 before breakfast - with his butter knife.

As I've listened to the various candidates claiming they are the one to break the deadlock, unite the country, and move us forward into a peaceful and prosperous future, I confess to a little cynicism. Who would want this poison chalice of being the Brexit Prime Minister? Look what it did to Theresa May and David Cameron. And why am I listening to the candidates anyway? Because, not being a member of the Conservative Party, I have no say in who will be the next leader of our nation, and neither probably do most of you. Only Conservative Party members will. So like most people, I will have to wait until the next general election to effect any change in that direction, and I'm not sure I've got the stomach for one of those anytime soon.

But joking aside and cynicism aside, we do all need to remember that one way or another the country will get through this. And as a Christian, I am reminded that the state authorities are there for the common good - or at least they should be. If we citizens switch off to all political matters no matter how exasperating they might be, then we will only ever get the kind of leaders we deserve and not the ones we desire. So hang in there! (I say this to myself as much as to you.) Keep positive, keep smiling, and keep praying for those in authority. It will get better, hopefully soon. Maybe Jo Konta will ace Wimbledon proves to be worthy of people's confidence and trust. this year. Maybe even the A303 will get widened one day too. Hope springs eternal.

North Tawton Neighbourhood Plan

The North Tawton Neighbourhood Plan is now at a crucial and exciting stage - Examination!

The Plan was submitted to West Devon Borough Council on 3rd April. WDBC was satisfied that the draft and accompanying documents complied with all the relevant statutory requirements. Regulation 16 consultation then followed which ended on 20th May. After this stage only 2 remain - Examination then Referendum. The Neighbourhood Plan Group await the response of the Examiner - Martin Lee, a chartered Town & Country Planning consultant who lives in Devon. We anticipate there will be points that we will need to address - at this stage we don't know how long this will take.

Once the Plan is acceptable to the Examiner WDBC will organise a referendum. This will be your chance to vote on whether you agree with the Plan or not. Won't be long now.....

Great Western Railway / Okerail Timetable

Copies of the latest train timetable are available at the Town Council Office, Post Office and local shops. From now until 8th September a Sunday service will run from Okehampton to Exeter four times a day. Plans to extend the service on a daily basis are being formulated.

NTTC Traffic and Parking Group

The Town Council will reconvene the Traffic and Parking Group during July. At the moment there is only one member of the public who attends the group and the Council would like to hear from anyone who is interested in joining this advisory group. It is proposed to hold a meeting in the Council Office on Thursday 11 July at 7 p.m..

You've taken my parking space – would you like my disability?

Further to several complaints about able bodied persons with no blue badge constantly parking their cars in designated disabled bays, thus making life even more difficult for those with disabilities, the Council has asked DCC Parking Enforcement to undertake patrols in the town. Please be aware that it is an offence to park in a disabled bay with no blue badge displayed, the Fixed Penalty Notice for this is £70.00.

It really is beyond foul...

I make no apology for raising yet again the issue of dog fouling. We continue to receive numerous complaints about this issue, which naturally causes strong feelings in those affected by the minority of dog owners who are not picking up after their dogs. In some areas this is happening on a daily basis. To the dog owners concerned, don't assume you are anonymous – I am frequently told by complainants that they know who is responsible. West Devon Borough Council localities officers have been asked to undertake patrols in the town, this will be in the early mornings and evenings as well as during normal working hours. West Devon will welcome witness statements from members of the public, with the identity of alleged perpetrators, relevant car registration numbers, and any other information that will help to take legal action against persons not picking up after their dogs. (Copies of witness statements are available from NTTC office - please be aware that witnesses must be prepared to attend court proceedings if cases go to court.) Perpetrators should be aware that failure to clean up after your dog can result in a fixed penalty notice of £80, or a prosecution with a maximum fine of £1,000. In North Devon on Friday 3rd May 2019 a complaint was made and a resident was fined for not picking up after their dog - please let this be a wake-up call and make a decision to help keep our lovely Town clean and safe for residents and visitors.







On Saturday 1st June 2019 church bell ringers from Chagford, Okehampton, Sampford Courtenay and South Tawton came together at All Saints church, Okehampton to celebrate the 50th Anniversary of the formation of the Okehampton Deanery Ringing Association.

In response to a letter supported and signed by Rev. D Bickerton of Sampford Courtenay (Rural Dean) and sent out on December 31st 1968 by Messrs B. Drake and P. Aggett to captains of towers in the Deanery, ringers representing eight towers met the Church Hall Okehampton on 17th January 1969 to discuss the possibility of holding a ringing competition.

Discussions were made on whether to hold a competition or a get together festival. Voting ended four towers for competition and four towers for a "get together" festival. The final decision was to initially hold a "get together" festival at North Tawton on 31st May 1969. Since then the Association has held annual festival/competition at various towers throughout the deanery as a way to encourage ringers' development with friendly competition.

The main section of Saturday's competition was narrowly won by Sampford Courtenay with 18 faults ahead of South Tawton on 18 ¼. The Novice section to encourage learners was won by Chagford, and Sampford Courtenay won the Intermediate Section. The competition was judged by Mr. B. Drake & Mr. M. Way of North Tawton.

Following the results, Rev. Stephen Cook took a service thanking all ringers for their continued efforts throughout the deanery. Celebrations continued after the results and included a 50th Anniversary cake and a glass of fizz. On behalf of the Association and all the ringers involved, a big thank you to the ringers of Okehampton for putting on a fantastic afternoon. Here's to the next 50 Years!




