# From The Rectory

# Come ye thankful people come

My annual marathon of Harvest services begins in just a few days time at Bondleigh with their service and Cider buffet. Then it will be Sampford Courtenay on Friday 27<sup>th</sup> Sept, North Tawton and Honeychurch on Sunday 6<sup>th</sup> October and a final traditional Harvest Evensong in North Tawton on Sunday 13<sup>th</sup> October. (Details of all these services are in this issue). The whole celebration takes about a month for me. I'll be "ploughed and scattered" by mid October.

Besides Harvest, there are a number of other events this autumn that are getting the residents of the Rectory excited. We all can't wait for Jesus Christ Superstar. Samuel and I are both in it, and the girls are looking forward to seeing it. (Again, details in this issue about this exciting production in St. Peter's Church). Then there are the various regular autumn excitements that my whole household usually enjoys.... bonfires/fireworks, Okehampton/Hatherleigh Carnivals (depending on which one gets the drier evening) and Strictly. Yes - we quite like Strictly. It is perfect Saturday evening viewing, and probably the only thing we all watch together. But I confess, as the latest series gets underway, I've been a little reluctant to join the sequined bandwagon this time. It seems to come round quicker each year. Maybe I've got Strictly fatigue? Maybe it's because there is something else this autumn that I am far more excited about... yes... the Rugby World Cup!

Trying very hard to resist the urge to fill the rest of this article with England rugby related punditry (I'm sure you'd all be fascinated to know my opinion as to whether Owen Farrell should pay fly half or inside centre), there are some depressing things to be noted this autumn as well. The nights are drawing in, Poldark has finished (Mrs. Weldon is very sad about that – I wonder why?), and Brexit refuses to stop getting more exasperating by the week. When will it ever go away? I think it's what contributes to that sense that Devon people are friendly people. Nevertheless, as we rejoice again at this time for the Harvest, I think we would all do well to cultivate a deeper attitude of thankfulness to last throughout the whole year.

In a world where people are obsessed with their grievances and rights and identities, thankfulness begins with an attitude that "it's not all about me." I realise not everyone is going to come in thankfulness to God for the ways in which he has sort to bless. Some simply do not believe in him, and so one presumes they have no one to thank but themselves when things go well in life. Yes atheism is ultimately worship of self, not just mere unbelief. But for many others, those who might not call themselves Christians or regularly engage in Christian worship, that sense in their hearts that there is someone out there who has sought to bless them is very clear. Nevertheless, having the attitude of heart that is at least open to the Almighty and thankful for his blessings is surely the better way. Think about it for a moment. As we look across harvested fields already being drilled for next year's harvest, as we pick blackberries, stew apples, and drink cider, whatever grievances we may have, to be alive in Devon in 2019 is to be blessed with so much... healthcare, security, fresh air, freedom, education, sport, wildlife, landscape, seascape, culture, and an abundance of locally produced food.

Some of the above might be less available or more expensive for a time after Br..... (oops! I nearly said it again!) But maybe some scarcity and a touch of vulnerability might actually be good for us. It might make us more thankful for what we have been blessed with and perhaps under-appreciate. So this Harvest time... come ye thankful people come. And, come on England!



# Highways issues.

The Strategic Highways Authority is Devon Highways (Devon County Council). It controls all aspects of managing highways, street parking, is also responsible for safety of the highways which include speeding restrictions and, if necessary, restricting HGV use. Currently, the enforcement of car parking is ceded to West Devon Borough Council.

North Tawton Town Council has therefore, very limited powers under the terms of the Highways Acts, Road Traffic Regulations and Parish Councils Acts as follows-

Power to maintain footpaths and bridleways

Power to light roads and public places

Power to enter into agreement re dedication and widening

Power to complain to the Highway Authority re unlawful stopping, obstruction of highway or unlawful encroachment on roadside wastes

Power to plant trees and layout grass verges

Give consent to end maintenance of highways at public expense, or for stopping up or division of highway.

Powers to provide parking places for bicycles and motor-cycles

Power to provide traffic signs and other notices

Power to provide seats and shelters.

## Parking and Traffic Working Group

Working within the parameters of these regulations, the Town Council Parking and Traffic Group is currently working closely with Devon Highways to –

Review street parking provision

Examine options with regard to HGV ingress through the town

Conduct a Traffic Survey Audit with a view to the introduction of an automated Speeding Warning device and relocation of the 30 m.p.h. sign at the Batheway Estate and speed limit review.

Review public transport provision.

With regard to HGV monitoring, during the month of October, residents are asked to e-mail or telephone the clerk with the following details regarding passage of HGV's through the town –

Date and time of observation, registration number and any identification on the vehicle e.g. company name etc. (01837 880121 or northtawton.towncouncil@yahoo.co.uk)

It is also concerning that Lloyds Mobile Bank has been unable to park in its allotted space in the Orchard Street car park for the last two weeks.

## **Dog Fouling**

Yet again, the Council is receiving a significant number of complaints about dog fouling. Recent offences under the Ant-Social Behaviour, Crime and Policing Act 2014 include fouling within St. Peter's Churchyard, High Street, Exeter Street and Market Street. Dog owners are reminded that the Warden who regularly visits the town has powers to impose an "on-the-spot" fine of £80 and refusal to pay can lead to a fine of £1,000 by the local Magistrates Court.

Dog mess is an eyesore and health hazard and owners should ensure they always carry a poop scoop and disposable bags (available locally).

# Plastic Waste Collection.

West Devon Borough Councils new "kerb-side" arrangements for plastic waste collection mean that the Council's award-winning scheme for collection on the third Saturday of the month will finish after the November collection. Both Councils wish to thank all volunteers for their time and assistance in making the scheme so successful.

## A statement from Tony Bayley, Sub Postmaster North Tawton Post Office:

The decision no longer to sell newspapers and magazines was not taken lightly, and I was fully aware of the impact and inconvenience this would have on some of our customers. The truth is that it has been losing money for over 18 months and was completely unsustainable, therefore the decision was taken after our suppliers, Smiths, increased their delivery charges out of all proportion. To this end I had no alternative. I genuinely apologise for this action that had to be taken. I no longer have the benefit of a healthy salary that previous owners had from the Post Office, as the Post Office has changed the payment structure to commission only, therefore the survival of North Tawton Post Office solely depends on our customers using our vast range of services and quality retail products.

Our manageress, June Savage, and her colleagues have worked tirelessly to refurbish the shop and introduce new lines that are not available elsewhere in the town and really deserve the town's support. Furthermore from 31st October, the Royal Mail will no longer be using North Tawton as a delivery centre. This has resulted in the loss of £12,500 per annum and in addition to this Royal Mail were intending that any letter or parcel that was not able to be delivered would have to be collected from Okehampton. Realising what a serious, highly inconvenient impact this would have on our customers, I had a meeting with the Royal Mail manager and Divisional manager and managed to secure North Tawton Post Office as a collection point for undelivered mail items.

As I'm sure many of you are aware 2000 - 2500 post offices will close in the next 6 months, due to businesses no longer being financially viable. 17 post offices in West and South Devon have closed in the first eight months of this year. I do not wish North Tawton to be added to this growing list. The long term future lies in the hands of the good people of North Tawton and I urge you to support June and her staff.
