

From The Rectory

What's the buzz, tell us what's a happening!

Well, there certainly *has* been a lot happening since we announced a few months ago that St. Peter's Troupers are putting on *Jesus Christ Superstar* – the iconic rock musical by Andrew Lloyd Webber and Tim Rice, which is presently being performed in London. But you don't need to venture further than North Tawton to see *Superstar* (as it's known) as it is being performed in St. Peter's church on 17th, 18th and 19th October. *(ticket details in "Roundabout" on page 15)*.

Our cast, musicians, stage crew (and importantly, those who keep us going with refreshments during rehearsals!) are working extremely hard to make this show the great success it deserves. As in past productions, new friendships have been formed. We laugh together and we share emotions, and because of the nature of this show, a group of us pray before rehearsals. We have welcomed several new members to St. Peter's Troupers. Some have their own stories to tell of how being part of this show has changed their lives. The choir from North Tawton Community Primary School has also been rehearsing, and will continue after returning to school in September. They are so keen and really amazing! Many of you will know that Superstar is about the final days of life on earth of Jesus Christ. But that certainly is not the end of the story - more the beginning! Indeed, our show will end on a high that will leave our audiences buzzing!

So what did happened next?

By every precedent of history, by every law of nature known then and now, by every experience of everybody, the story of Jesus should have ended with his burial. Not only was he dead but he had been brutally and publicly killed in such a humiliating and disgraceful manner that it was obvious to all that he was not God's promised Messiah. Jesus's followers had been shamed, scared and scattered. It is hard to imagine a more definite, public and final closure to the story of Jesus. It was the end. But it wasn't. Something happened. A something that transformed Jesus's followers and ultimately transformed the world; a something that made Passover A.D. 30 not the disappointing end of a sad story in an obscure part of the world, but the beginning of a vast and unsurpassed epic that has shaped and shaken history on every continent and that remains unfinished. That this something was a single event – the bodily resurrection of Jesus from the dead – is the foundation of all Christian belief, past and present. Without the resurrection, Christianity would not exist. What Jesus taught repeatedly focused on who he

was. Jesus said 'I am the truth for you to have'. If Jesus had died a criminal, abandoned and cursed by God and stayed dead, then the authority and validity of everything he said would be fatally and finally undermined. That is not just today's verdict but, significantly, it was also the verdict at the time. Around A.D. 53 Paul wrote to Christians in Corinth: 'And if Christ has not been raised, then all our preaching is useless, and your faith is useless...And if Christ has not been raised, then your faith is useless and you are still guilty of your sins'. Barely two decades after the crucifixion, Paul, who knew personally some of the people involved in the trial and crucifixion, was making the astonishing statement that the Christian faith stood or fell on the reality of the resurrection of Jesus.

At the heart of the idea of the resurrection is the astounding belief that Jesus himself is alive, not just as an historical figure but as a present reality; a living person who we can communicate with and relate to. The testimony of Christians over the centuries is that this continues to be true: Jesus is alive and can be experienced as someone who transforms lives. Those who truly want to find the risen Jesus, not out of idle curiosity but ready to make him Saviour, King and Lord of their lives, can still find him.

For the disciples, the resurrection was not simply an historical fact; it was also a personal experience. After Jesus had left them, the two on the road to Emmaus said to each other, 'Didn't our hearts burn within us as he talked with us on the road and explained the Scriptures to us?' Since that day billions of people have experienced a similar 'warming of the heart' as they have encountered the risen, living Jesus. That has certainly happened to some members of *Superstar*. Indeed, it is that personal experience of the presence of the resurrected Jesus that lies at the very heart of the best and most complete Christian faith. To believe in the resurrection of Jesus changes how we live.

So, come and experience *Superstar* at St. Peter's. You will see some amazingly talented performers and musicians, brilliant scenery, sound and lighting. And at the end of the show, you will see that the cross shines forth, bringing hope for us all.

Remembered a century on, North Tawton's last casualty of the Great War.

Private James Bovey, 2nd /6th Devon regiment.

He died on 19th September 1919 in Mesopotamia, and is buried in Tehran Cemetery, Iran.

His home was in High Street in North Tawton.




During the past five years "Roundabout" has remembered by name all those who fell in the Great War of 1914 –1918 as was done St. Peter's Church in October last year at the Commemoration of the 1918 Armistice.

James Bovey's death (above) gives a final reminder that there were casualties almost a year after hostilities ended. It reminds us too, that for years afterwards many who survived the war had to live with injuries, mental and physical, caused by their involvement in the war. Some never returned to "normal" health

despite help offered by charities, notably the Royal British Legion. It and others continue today to help others affected by the wars which, sadly, have thrown up further generations of casualties since.

"We will remember them"

ROUNDABOUT

Climate Emergency Network. Bottom Up.

Many of you will know that North Tawton is part of the UNESCO-designated North Devon Biosphere Reserve. It covers the entire area of land draining to the Rivers Taw and Torridge, and the sea out beyond Lundy. As an internationally recognised site, ranking alongside the World Heritage Sites, the North Devon Biosphere Reserve is determined to be an exemplar to the rest of the UK, for the sustainable management of the land, and nature. However, the Biosphere system is very different to other Protected Areas, which have traditionally had a 'Top-down' format, so that a government designates a particular Protected Area, sets up a team to manage it, and gives that team some responsibility, some authority and some money (though never enough). The Biosphere is expected to operate the other way, bottom-up, collating the efforts of many individuals and organisations for the greener future, including the climate emergency.


Climate change does seem, at last, largely accepted, and acknowledged to be a major emergency. There are some who still believe it is nonsense, just as there are those who believe that the earth is flat, but perhaps now a minority. In Devon, many Parish Councils are declaring a Climate Emergency, but are less sure what to do about it, as so many of the obvious levers of power lie in Westminster, or Exeter, or even Torridge D.C. in Bideford. Many, though, do understand that it is the action of individual people and groups who matter. The answer lies in talking to each other, finding good ideas from all over the area and spreading North Tawton's own good ideas, whether coming from the council, other groups, or individuals. Do not ask 'What can the Biosphere do for me? But what can I do for the Biosphere?' We ask every Parish and Town to nominate a Climate Emergency Reporter, who will give a report on progress every year to both the Parish Council and to the Biosphere team. This person may or may not be a councillor, may or may not claim any particular expertise in environmental matters, may do it on their own, but more likely gather a team around them.

Once names have been submitted, networking can start. The Biosphere team will be listening, and will be prepared to help with some expertise, but they will not be telling parish reporters what to do or how to do it. This really is a bottom-up exercise. Before long, I trust the Network will decide on some organisation of its own. Then we can really start motoring (electric cars of course). I am told that a network of parishes would not find it difficult to access Lottery and other funds.

Over to you, councillors and people of North Tawton. You do not need to take the slightest notice of this initiative, but you may have to explain to your children and grandchildren why you decided to take no action.







ROUNDABOUT

The Doctor Jean Shields Memorial Day

This meeting was held in St. Peter's church on Saturday 10th August. What was agreed to be a most enjoyable and informative day was attended by nearly one hundred people, both local and from beyond Exeter.

Steve Stocker has been studying the route of the Roman Road between North Tawton and Okehampton for many years. He gave us an illustrated talk on how he became involved in the investigation of the road, and on what can be seen today, including some very interesting photographs of the paved road buried over a foot deep in the woodlands near Rowden. This work continues and Steve Stoker would be very interested to know any information or memories about the road. He can be reached at Blogg's garage which is advertised elsewhere in "Roundabout". (page 4)

Dr. Chris Smart and Dr. João Fonte are professional archaeologists attached to the Archaeology Department at the University of Exeter. They are running a project called "Understanding Landscapes". They are carrying out digging projects in Calstock and Ipplepen and they receive some funding the Heritage Lottery Fund. Recently, they have been working with North Tawton volunteers on the remarkable Roman sites in the area of DeBathe cross. This work is funded by Devon County Council and Historic England. They have access to research methods not available to amateurs. This includes the recent technique of LIDAR which can reveal the contours of the land below vegetation. They are part way through detecting remains of Roman buildings and features concealed on the land to the south of North Tawton. This work has already shown some remarkable new information.

The ten acre "fort" on Nigel Dunn's land is surrounded by a construction of over 80 acres which could date from the Roman invasion in the first century A.D.. Although it is thought that the Second Augustan Legion was based in Exeter it is now known that they came much further west. Our Roman remains may have been their base for a period. At that time North Tawton could have been larger than Exeter. Up to 5000 troops commanded by the future Emperor Vespasian could have been stationed close to the site of the Railway Inn. The present investigations are throwing up many puzzling features and the results are still being investigated. There may even have been an amphitheatre to entertain troops close to DeBathe cross.

These talks were followed by a well attended visit to the site of the features beyond the railway where the Roman Road would have crossed the River Taw.

Okehampton and District Local History Society is grateful for all the help given in order to arrange this day in honour of Dr. Jean Shields who did so much to communicate the history of North Tawton and West Devon. Thanks for the day go especially to Steve Stocker, Nigel Dunn and Rev'd. Nick Weldon.




