Litter pick Village Hall to New Inn	Gloves, litter grabber, black bags.	
Litter pick Sampford Chapple to Dornaford Cross	Gloves, litter grabber, black bags.	
Litter pick Wellsprings Lane	Gloves, litter grabber, black bags.	
Litter pick Main Road from Greenhill Cross to Solland	Gloves, litter grabber, black bags.	
Litter pick from Square to Red Post, to Thornbury Cross & back to Village Hall	Gloves, litter grabber, black bags.	
Hedge Trim Public Toilets	Gloves, Hedge Trimmer, Strimmer, fork	
Weed around Millennium Stone and War Memorials	Gloves, litter grabber, black bags.
