Live Traffic: This information is provided by satnavs and google Green – running smoothly Amber – mild congestion Red – mild to heavy congestion

Road Closure and diversions & roadworks: This information shows all roads closed for the timeframe chosen (top right bar)

Click on the icon with to find the notice which provides more detail on the closure

<u>Traffic restrictions:</u> Shows footway closures, temporary speed limits etc, for the timeframe picked (top right bar)

Public events :

This shows all the special events in Devon, for the timeframe picked (top right bar)

Data	Layers

Main features on the home page which you can turn on or off



Roadworks:

You can filter what types of roadworks you want to see eg; high impact, medium or all

Driver information: Purple routes show gritter routes – currently getting updated Speed camera and M5 information boards are also shown

Public transport: Tells you times of trains

and buses

Live incidents: This can show you many things from incidents, accidents, weather incidents and floods etc

Operation Info: -Forward planning, shows works before they have been noticed/ confirmed -Section 58, this is when we have completed major works and want to protect our asset - Bridge restrictions are

also shown

What information can be seen about a traffic order on one.network?

To find out more about a traffic order click on the icon. In most cases the pop-up box will confirm dates of traffic order along with a description of the work taking place, what road is closed and the diversion.

Traffic order documents may also be attached; this provides more information and shows a written description of the diversion.
