

COVID 19 REGULATIONS FOR RE-OPENING PUBLIC TOILETS

SAMPFORD COURTENAY PARISH COUNCIL ask all USERS to read the following advice carefully: -

We are re-opening the public toilets for the convenience of both parishioners and visitors. However, in line with Government Guidance there remains risks from using such facilities. The measures set out below will enable all users to be as safe as possible. Please respect other users.

Cleaning and hygiene

Scientific advice suggests that the virus can survive for up to several days on some hard surfaces, particularly when indoors.

The Parish Council request that all users help us to manage these potential risks by observing the following rules: -

- Please observe **the good handwashing technique**, (as per additional poster) and remember the need to increase handwashing frequency and to avoid touching your face, and to cough or sneeze into a tissue which is binned safely, or into your arm if a tissue is not available.
- To ensure **social distancing** please observe a “one in, one out” system when using the toilets.
- Please use the **hand sanitiser** provided on entry and exit of the toilets.
- Please help to **Keep the facilities well ventilated**, by ensuring outer doors and windows remain open.
