Dartmoor Railway line

Dear neighbour,

To ensure the safe passage of trains on the new improved Dartmoor railway line which will be opening later this year, we will shortly be carrying out essential vegetation clearance and slope stabilisation works.

We will be working 500m southwest of Sampford Courtenay Station to remove vegetation and stabilise the rock slope. Our work will involve the use of chainsaws and other power tools so some noise will be generated. Due to the nature of this work we will be working at night when driver training is not taking place.

We will be working on the below dates and times, so our teams can work safely, but please be aware these dates may change. We will also be working during the day when it is safe to do so.
