## Notes below refer to 2021-22 Monthly Spend v Budget Spreadsheet.

### Tab 1 – General Funds

- Column D (Yellow) shows figures Budgeted
- Column E (Pink) shows total spend to date for each item
- NB Column F shows figures for March 2021, because our books closed on 31<sup>st</sup> March 2021 and payments for March were only agreed at April meeting. This will have an effect on the end of year accounts for March 2022.

# Tab 2 – VAT

Shows VAT still to be claimed for this year – as expenditure is entered net of VAT, this refund will be paid back into general funds.

## Tab 3 – Income

Income still expected for P3 money (£10,000) and Wind Farm Contribution (£1,250) + Locality Fund Grant for Dartmoor Line Survey from Cllr James McInnes.

Monthly Seamoor Lotto contributions will continue and VAT Refund as detailed above.

# Tab 4 – EMR – Ear Marked Reserves

- Column C (Yellow) shows the totals of all EMR at start of this financial year.
- Column D shows Budgeted totals from Precept to meet expected expenditure during this year.
- Column E (Pink) shows current totals to date.

### NB

- Elections still awaiting Invoice for SCPC share of May 21 Elections.
- Church Clock Fund Budgeted Transfer of £25 still to be made this year.
- S137 Fund now includes what was held under "Other Charitable Support" still to pay £100 British Legion Wreath. It should be noted that this fund can amount to £4,398.43 but it was agreed to build this contingency fund up incrementally over a number of years

 $(2021-22 \text{ S137 Allowance } \pounds 8.41 \text{ per electorate} = 523 \text{ x } \pounds 8.41 = \pounds 4,398.43)$ 

• Parish Inclusion Fund (£750) – This was the fund set up to contribute to joint parish events, and has twice been used to donate £500 x 2 to the St Andrews/Village Hall Fund with regard to Parish Fetes. In light of this year's

changes to Standing Orders and Financial Regulations – do councillors feel this fund should now be incorporated with the S137 fund, and the £250 per year which was normally allocated to this fund, added to the £200 suggested annual addition to build up S137 fund as per above?

- SCEnSus Clerk is holding £80.40 cash from Bug Hotel Event.
- Dartmoor Line Working Party as above still awaiting Locality Fund Grant.
- Village Hall Fund some expenditure expected to cover costs of Cupboard in Meeting Room to securely house Projector and Screen etc.
- VE Day and Face Masks suggestion for Open Meeting that this is used to fund Jubilee Bench etc.

### Tab 5 – CIK – Contributions in Kind

SCPC is very grateful to the regular band of parishioners who have given their time over this last 6 months, which equates to almost £1,000.
