

Our Torrington Mobile Library service is currently suspended due to an out of hours incident that has destroyed its mobile vehicle

The team at Libraries Unlimited are devastated as this incident will affect the library service to our customers in rural locations and especially for those that may not be able to get to another library. We are an independent charity, and this incident will also impact us in terms of financial implications, staff time and resources needed to get our service back on the road.

Libraries Unlimited Chief Executive, Alex Kittow said, "We are devasted by the news that our much-loved Torrington Mobile Library has been destroyed by fire over the weekend. Understandably this incident has hit the local team particularly hard. They are working to oversee the clean up process as well as informing customers that the mobile library service will be off the road whilst we sort temporary solutions."

Our staff will be contacting customers to update them personally on the suspension of the service and we will be working with partners and other stakeholders to try and identify ways of getting a mobile service back on the road as soon as possible.

Goodbye and thank you to Cllr. Jean Trewhitt

Jean joined NTTC in 2015 and was a very highly thought of and proactive member of the council and will be missed. Together with others, Jean helped develop and achieve the making of North Tawton Neighbourhood Plan and was the Chairperson of the Town Council for a year. Sadly, Jean has resigned from NTTC as she is leaving the Parish and we wish her good luck and happiness in her new home.

Council Vacancies

The vacancy left by Jean has been advertised and we hope to fill the vacancy as soon as possible. In July we co-opted Alec Ranford to the Council, and we welcome him and look forward to working with him on behalf of the Parish

Cemetery Extension.

The Council have appointed PCL planning consultants to prepare the planning application for the proposed cemetery extension, and they are in the process of gathering the required reports and surveys prior to submission.

Pavilion in the Memorial Park

The council are waiting for tenders from companies for a pavilion in the park using monies obtained via a grant from Denbrook Community Fund.

Housing Needs Survey

The council will be working with West Devon BC – Alex Rehaag, to produce a conclusion to the HNS and look into assisting the formation of a Community Land Trust for the Town.

Town Clerk

Sadly, the Deputy Town Clerk has resigned, and the Council have now increased the Town Clerk to 32 hours per week rather than seek to appoint a Deputy Clerk. Stephen Webb, who used to be Assistant Clerk will locum up to 3 hours per week whilst the Town Clerk is on leave to answer urgent enquiries. The Town Council office is open for 'drop-in' between 10 a.m. and 12.30 p.m. on Mondays and Fridays. Appointments can be made outside of these hours if you need to speak to the Town Clerk or a councillor at a different time.

Development 'Phase II Batheway'

The Town council has requested a site meeting with the developers 'Allison Homes', to discuss Residents' concerns and progress of the build. Please refer to West Devon Planning website and search for planning reference 1549/18/FUL to see the approved plans for the site. Should you have any concerns that a planning breach is occurring, it should be reported directly to West Devon Planning Enforcement department as soon as evident, via the West Devon planning website.

Ramblings of a North Tawton W.I. Member

I love to peruse the shelves of a second-hand bookshop. Husband waits outside. It's not his thing. This particular bookshop was in Lynton, tucked away behind their lovely Town Hall. Did you know that (according to the Visit Lynton and Lynmouth website) their Town Hall is a 'strange mixture of mock-Gothic, neo-Tudor and art nouveau design'. It's a beautiful building, inside and out. Go and have a look. Tell them I sent you. Anyway – back to the bookshop. My eye was drawn to the spine of a book that reads as follows: - 'Wise Words & Country Ways – Weather Lore'. For a fleeting moment I wondered if husband had secretly secured a publishing deal. But no. Unless he has decided to adopt the pen name 'Ruth Binney'. I had to buy it of course. It's full of stories and sayings about the weather and forecasting. A subject closer to husband's heart than his Dickie's boiler suit. Let me give you an example of the wise and wonderful sayings from this book. 'Never offer your hen for sale on a rainy day'. Got that? Would you like one more? 'Dry your barley in October, or you'll always be sober'. Thank you, Ruth Binney. (translations next time if needed).

Stuart Luxton offered us a wise old saying as part of his talk about 'Farmer Luxtons'. When it comes to customer service there are two rules. Rule 1 – the customer is always right. Rule 2 – If the customer is wrong, refer to Rule 1. Brilliant.

Stuart introduced us to the Luxton family and described how his parents taught him the simple value of hard work. After finishing college, it was off to university to study agriculture as, in Stuart's opinion, he would probably be spending the rest of his life in Okehampton. He returned to the family farm where, after an initial refusal from his dad, Stuart's suggestion of opening a farm shop met with a 'yes'. What followed was an incredibly steep learning curve. Stuart went on to talk about the business as it is now, how customer service is at the heart of everything they do, how they keep to exactly the same recipes, and how proud he is of his lovely team. Farmer Luxtons employs nearly 40 people and Stuart was keen to point out how important it is to him to take on young apprentices. He describes his business as 'traditional' – a butcher that can supply everything. Questions from the audience included 'how can I get crispy crackling' – (it helps if you've got a special crackling button on your oven) and 'who does the cooking at home' (his wife). He included advice on sharpening knives and how barbecuing is more popular than ever – (ask him for a Boston Butt next time you're firing up the barbie). One thing was very clear – his total commitment and passion to his team, his trade and his customers.

Ever been to Bridge Mill at Bridgerule near Holsworthy? North Tawton W.I. have. It's like stepping back in time. A restored working water mill and a 16-acre organic smallholding with ponds, a vegetable garden and beautifully managed, natural flower plantings. Rosie and Alan have created a haven of escapism – with tea and home-made cake on the side. An air-conditioned coach was much appreciated too, with a wonderfully helpful driver who didn't seem to mind the raucous rendition of 'Happy Birthday' to Ro's mum. We had a quick whip round for the wonderfully helpful driver – (not sure what he'll do with the foreign coin that was spotted in the collection pot). Sue Knott
