

# **Bound Together!**

The Platinum Jubilee celebrations of our Queen's 70 year reign are over – and what wonderful celebrations they were! Not just the spectacular parades, service and concert in London, but also those held in many communities across the country. People uniting, coming together in order to plan and participate in church services, street parties and all sorts of events to celebrate a truly unique occasion. And, after two years of unpredictable restrictions due to the pandemic, this marked the end to isolation and solitude for so many people with the opportunity of being with family, friends and neighbours.

People uniting and pulling together reminds me of the huge redwood trees in California. They are the largest living things on earth and the tallest trees in the world. Some of them are 300 feet high and more than 2,500 years old. You would think that trees that large would have a tremendous root system, reaching down hundreds of feet into the earth. But that is not the case. Redwoods have a very shallow root system. The roots of these trees are, however, intertwined. They are tied in with each other, interlocked. Therefore, when the storms come and the winds blow the redwoods still stand. With an interlocking root system they support and sustain each other. They need one another to survive. So do we!

Through Christ we are bound together in a community of faith. Belonging to Christ we belong to each other. Fellowship with Christ means fellowship with each other. Through Christ God has made us a family, a community of faith. This is our God-given support system.

Very little of the language of the Bible is about the

individual, about 'my' or 'I'. It is about community, about 'our' and 'we'. We read that it was 200 leaders of the tribe of Issachar (and their relatives!) who understood the times and knew the best course for God's people to take.

'From the tribe of Issachar, there were 200 leaders of the tribe with their relatives. All these men understood the signs of the times and knew the best course for Israel to take.' (1 Chronicles 12:32)

Leaders, relatives and the nation were united together.

Our churches are not just places of worship, but places for sharing sorrows, joys and hopes. We sing, pray and praise God, not as individuals, but together as a church family. It is a feeling of 'belonging' and of wanting to reach out and encourage others in the community to come and join this family. Everyone is welcome into this family - whether you have been to church before or not. There are a wide variety of services across our group of churches, so there is something for everyone (details in Roundabout). 

# Ramblings of a North Tawton W.I. Member

Dr. Dianne Long was here to talk about the Devon Gardens Trust which is itself a member of the Gardens Trust, the national charity dedicated to the conservation of designed landscapes, parks, gardens and cemeteries in England and Wales, to researching their history and campaigning on their behalf. Dianne wove her talk around the history and definition of the word 'garden' – a designed landscape, an area of pleasure, an enclosed space containing plants, trees, fruit or even animals. Did you know that as early as the 11<sup>th</sup> century there was a deer park in Winkleigh? In fact, in Devon alone there were at least 45 deer parks – apart from being used for game they would contain stock ponds for fish, rabbit warrens and dovecotes – a good example being Holcombe Court which, alongside it's four fish ponds and dovecote, is considered to be the best Tudor building in Devon. Great Fulford House with its unusual wall that has niches for 'bee-boles' – Shilstone House near Modbury, which is undergoing restoration, and has a series of lakes connected by cascades and rills along with a 17<sup>th</sup> Century water theatre – Castle Hill, Filleigh with its 'Triumphal Arch' and the stunning Haldon Belvedere, built by Sir Richard Palk in 1788, originally as a summer house – the list goes on. Dianne's intimate knowledge of these wonderful Devon landscapes, parks and gardens was fascinating – and a lovely way to take a tour of our beautiful county.

Did you see us in the Jubilee Parade? Waving our placards, wearing our aprons and sashes and (according to husband) looking rather formidable. But in a friendly way. I think it gave us a taste for marching – I think we could be tempted to do more sash wearing and placard waving for the right cause. Such as 'Compulsory Chocolate Consumption on Days of the Week With a 'Y' in Them' and 'Housework Should Only Be Done When It's Raining' (according to husband)

And then there was cake. Lots and lots of cake. Our Senior's Tea Party on Jubilee Saturday was awash with sarnies, scones and cake. And gallons of tea. Hurrah for our W.I. bakers who baked their W.I. socks/support tights off to produce an afternoon tea fit for a Queen. I hope she enjoyed a very generous slice of 'light as a feather' sponge cake in her own honour.

# Sampford Courtenay Environment and Sustainability (SCEnSus)



Seasonal Suggestion - July

With the Summer holidays approaching and with more of us than ever staying close to home and watching how much we spend on days out why not 'look local'? Whether you've got school-age children to entertain or adults visiting you over the Summer then have a look at the Devon Wildlife Trust website for some ideas of what to do and where to go. Did you know that the Trust has 58 Nature Reserves within the County of varying sizes and each with a different focus? They also have a number of initiatives that you can take part in as individuals, as a family or in community groups. Why not use this Summer to make your garden a 'haven for wildlife' and you might qualify for a free plaque to display in your garden. Sign up for their free e-Newsletters, maybe give someone Membership of the Trust as a birthday present (also available for a couple or family). Along the same lines, you might want to browse other related websites – the Devon Treescapes project or the Devon Biodiversity Records Centre or the Devon Bat Survey for example. Lots to do and plenty to find out about – all at virtually no cost.

Assuming that we might get a few days when the weather is too hot to be outside for long you might also want to be indoors doing some research on something else that has come to my attention recently – Bokashi! If, like me, you hadn't heard the term before then it seems to be being talked about everywhere. A very old Japanese composting technique it's being used by farmers and gardeners alike. Even people with no garden (just household waste or even dog poo) are using it to speed up the composting process, apparently. It's uses anaerobic fermentation to produce a liquid and solids that are rich in nutrients – just the thing we need with fertiliser prices rocketing. It doesn't heat up like normal compost does and, apparently, doesn't smell! If you're well ahead on this one and have already done the research and maybe you've even been doing it for years then please make contact with us through the Clerk at Sampford Courtenay Parish Council so that we can find out more and spread the word!



# **Bondleigh Rainfall**

May's rainfall amounted to 67.5mm. another fairly inconspicuous month, slightly higher than average, but very much lower than last year. In 2021, May's rainfall was 170.4mm. As we head towards mid-summer, 2022 has all the makings of a dry year. We shall see!

Danny Semorad

The meteorological equipment at Danny's farm is subject to periodic inspection by the Met office. At his most recent inspection, Danny mentioned his readings are printed in "Roundabout" and was offered the article below which we are pleased to publish:

# MET OFFICE AND WEATHER RECORDING

The Met Office first emerged in 1854 under the leadership of Captain Robert Fitzroy for the Board of Trade. We have constantly evolved over the years to our current position and one of the most technologically advanced organisations in the U.K..

We first begun doing short range forecasts for the shipping fraternity, this was instigated by the now Admiral Fitzroy who made ships record the weather, and noticed there were short range patterns that could be predicted.

Modern day forecasts are carried out by large supercomputers that run extremely complex models and can work on a local or global scale. Humans still have an important input, and there are many forecasters working around the U.K. covering many industries from oil & gas to aviation.

Detailed weather records have been kept for centuries, although mainly since the 1700's. The first reliable records were made by members of the church who usually were the only members of a parish who could write. In 1859 things became more organised with the start of the British Rainfall Organization set up by George Symons. As its name suggests, it was a dedicated network of rainfall recording stations throughout the U.K.

Nowadays the Met Office & Environment Agency manage these networks and collates the data for the people of the U.K.. We manage four networks of recording stations, and all the data is collated in our Archive in Exeter. As we are a publicly funded body, the data is freely available to public. If you are in Exeter and have a free afternoon, may I recommend you visit; there are some extremely interesting records.

The four networks are:

Rainfall – These sites only record rainfall and are usually read once a day. There are around 2700 of these sites in the U.K. managed by the EA, NRW, SEPA, Met. Office and other bodies.

Climate – These sites manually record data including temperatures, rainfall, weather, sunshine, wind and cloud on a daily basis and report once a day. There are over 150 of these.

Automatic Weather stations - These record data continually, but log the data and report occasionally. There are 74 of these.

Synoptic stations – Fully automated sites that record everything from pressure to rainfall and report in real-time. There are about 156 of these.

These numbers are currently correct but we are always making efforts to increase these numbers.

The data has countless uses ranging from forecasting to scientific studies into flora and fauna. Many of our observers are volunteers and range from the farming community to people just interested in the weather as a hobby. We owe these observers a huge debt as we have an extensive and accurate archive that is the envy of many of our international counterparts.

Just as a matter of interest, below is a list of the extremes we have experienced in the U.K.

Highest Temperature - 38.7°C – Cambridge in 2019.

Lowest Temperature - 27.2°C – Braemar in 1982. Highest wind speed - 142m.p.h. – Fraserburgh in 1989.

Highest Rainfall in 24 hours – 279mm in Dorset in 1955

(In 2009 there were devastating floods in Cumbria, whilst this didn't break the 24 hour record it received 495mm in 4 days. This is a record and the prolonged nature of the rain was damaging)

Crib Goch (Snowdonia) - A monthly rainfall total of 1396mm. was recorded in the calendar month (gauge read at 1010 UTC on 1 December 2015 and again at 1346 UTC on 1 January 2016). This is a record for a monthly total in the UK.

School days are busy, and teachers are always on the go. When a child says, 'Can I help?' it is music to our ears! From sharpening pencils, to helping younger children in the dinner hall, tidying the library shelves to sweeping autumn leaves in playground, our children really enjoy helping, and we really appreciate it! To instil important lessons through experiences of citizenship, and to support the efficient running of our classrooms, children are given class responsibilities for handing out and collecting books, fruit, resources and equipment, tidying and organising the class. In all my years, I've never known a child to not enjoy 'their turn to be 'in charge' of these jobs. We hope that by giving our children an understanding of belonging and community, they will choose to think about how their actions, however big or small, can benefit others not only now, but in their lives ahead.

Start children off the way they should go, and even when they are old, they will not turn from it. (Proverbs 22:6)

Volunteers are everywhere in our world. They are running food banks, sports clubs, Brownies and Cubs, providing critical and emergency aid, raising funds for charities and engaged in many other activities which directly support local, national and international communities. At North Tawton Primary School we have four very important groups which are integral to the smooth running and success of the school. These groups are made up of volunteers who apply for the roles and are democratically voted to the positions.

### **School Council**

A group of children meets with Mr. Foreman to discuss matters of interest and represent pupil voice in school development. The School Council consists of two pupils from each KS1 and KS2 class to represent the interests of our 6 - 11 year-olds.

### Local Stakeholder Board

This group monitors school development, specifically equity and compliance, and are 'critical friends' to the school leaders. The LSB is made up of adults who represent our North Tawton community voice, including parents, local community members and school staff.

### **Trustees**

This group holds the senior leadership of the Dartmoor Academy Trust to account. They oversee finance and compliance, and work with the Trust to set the long-term strategic direction.

They are made up of people with a passion for our Dartmoor communities and the professional experience and skills needed for this accountable role.

### Friends of North Tawton

This group is made up of North Tawton parents and carers. They work with school leaders to organise fundraising events and represent the parents and carers voice. The funds they raise support extracurricular experiences to enhance our curriculum such as visits, excursions, and materials for additional creative sessions.
