

From The Rectory

You crown the year with your bounty, and your carts overflow with abundance. The grasslands of the wilderness overflow; the hills are clothed with gladness. The meadows are covered with flocks and the valleys are mantled with grain; they shout for joy and sing.

(Psalm 65:11-13)

Happy Harvest! In our churches we are in the middle of celebrating our Harvest Festivals in September and October. Unlike Remembrance or Christmas there is not a day set aside to celebrate the harvest, but it is a season – each school, church or village celebrating at different times. This is maybe apt as the harvest does not happen on one day but is the result of hard work over months. With different crops gathered at different times.

Whether we ourselves are out in the fields or not, harvest is a time for gladness and thankfulness. Whether we believe in a god or not, it is important, and beneficial, to be thankful for what we have — much or little, through hard work or through a gift. Being grateful for what we have helps us to enjoy what we have and helps us to look outwards to others and their contribution to our life and sustenance. Previously, when I worked in large towns and cities, this was doubly important as there people are much less aware of where their food comes from, and don't appreciate

either the effort made by others or how reliant crops are on the weather that comes.

Christians and the Jewish people before them sang songs of thankfulness such as Psalm 65 quoted above to say thank you to God for all they had. They recognized that it was ultimately God who provided the seed, soil and weather – and the flocks too – that they relied on.

The words of Psalm 65 (in the Hebrew language it was originally written in) can actually be read in two ways as a prayer of thankfulness for past harvests and food, but also as a prayer for coming good harvests and abundant provision. With food ever increasing in cost, many of us might be echoing this prayer. And it reminds us that Harvest is also a time for sharing the good things we have received. It's wonderful that in North Tawton we have such ventures as the community fridge, the library of things and the repair café where food, tools and skills are shared, so that what one person has in abundance can be shared with others. There is a blessing in sharing with others, as Jesus himself said – it is more blessed to give than to receive. And this also means we can be the answer to our own prayers – as we share what we have with others, others share with us what we need. Let's continue to be a sharing community!



North Tawton Afternoon W.I.

Ramblings of a North Tawton W.I. Member

Warning. This may well be a bit more rambly [rambley?] than usual. It's hot. Very hot. And my concentration is not what it should be. Some may say that wouldn't make any difference. Let's have a flick through the Devon W.I. News magazine. Is that a group of North Tawton W.I. ladies on the front cover? Hang on – isn't that them on page four? And page six? [knocking back the gin] Looks like them again on page seven. It can't be them again on page eight? Oh yes. No less than FIVE appearances in the news magazine, showing other Devon W.I.'s what we get up to. Some may call it 'over exposure' [A quick Google of that phrase tells me it means 'excessive media coverage, especially to the point that people lose interest'] Can't risk that – maybe just one or two appearances in the next edition then. Wouldn't want to be accused of hogging the limelight. Let's talk about British Sign Language. Our speaker was Beth Bartholomew and she was accompanied by Clare, her interpreter. Beth has been a member of the Deaf community for over 30 years, she is fluent in British Sign Language [BSL] has over 10 years of teaching experience and is currently a lecturer at Exeter University teaching a variety of different levels of BSL. Beth and Clare worked together seamlessly, going through the various types of deafness and communication methods and the different forms of sign language. Lip reading seems like an obvious way of communicating with a deaf person but, interestingly, 70% of lipreading is guesswork and it is not an effective form of communication by itself. Beth advised us to wait for eye contact from the person who is deaf, keep your hands away from your mouth, check that your face isn't in shadow, speak normally [don't shout] and don't be embarrassed to write things down if necessary – and don't ever say 'don't worry, it doesn't matter' and not try to communicate, as it can leave a deaf person feeling very

BSL was introduced in 1975 as the native language of deaf people and is a language in its own right, it is a very physical language system of communication using facial expressions and mouth patterns as well as gestures. Now it was over to us. A demonstration of the BSL alphabet was followed by an attempt to spell our names and to introduce ourselves to our neighbour. You could feel the level of concentration rise as fingers, thumbs and faces were put into use — a challenging exercise that was a good way to begin to appreciate just how important the language is to its users and it certainly gave us a snapshot of how life is for someone in the Deaf community.

Husband hasn't had a mention yet. [He has now] Do you love to hear the beautiful sound of church bells being rung? You do? Then you'll be overjoyed to know that a group of us will be having a lesson in bellringing in the autumn. That's made you sit up and listen, hasn't it? Might ask our lovely pharmacy to bulk buy ear plugs. Could cause panic buying.







News From North Tawton Community Primary School



Art at Our School

Our children love to draw, paint and sculpt! Over the two years I have been here, I have been so impressed by the individual and the collaborative work the children have created and displayed. Not only do we have a passionate member of staff leading on all things arty, we have been blessed with local artists also sharing their skills and passion with our children.

Juliet Boyce, our school art lead, writes the following:

"At the end of last term, we enjoyed a number of art workshops led by local artists. Emmeline Webb, a textiles artist, came to teach year 4 all about printing techniques. Emmeline is a local artist who creates colourful, abstract art which is then turned into fabrics. Her work is inspired by William Morris. The class practised carving a design into a polystyrene tile and then used ink and rollers to make a series of prints of their designs.

PJ Grey gave a clay workshop inspired by Anthony Gormley's figures. The Year 3 children practised sculpting tiny figures and used their imaginations to bring some individuality to their work. PJ explained about the history of clay.

Year 1 walked down to the gallery to find out about the artist in residence Ruth Batham. They noticed that she uses lots of red, yellow and orange in her work, and that all of her paintings included babies and parents. They then came back to school with Ruth and enjoyed a colour mixing workshop.

Year 5 spent an afternoon with local artist Ruth Smith, working with acrylic paints. Ruth talked through some examples of her landscape paintings and the children had a go at mixing colours and created beautiful nature inspired art.

Year 2 and 6 will be working with Jason Ewing in September to create some stop motion animation scenes. Jason is a local graphic designer, who has been volunteering in Year 3 this year.

Thank you to all the artists who have volunteered their time to work with our school and to the parents who have helped out as well. We are so lucky to have such a creative community. We look forward to making this an annual event."

A huge thank you to Juliet Boyce and to Ruth Smith for organising this and other art projects over the year. If you have a skill you can share with our school children, or just some time to help us in class for example by listening to children read, please let me know!

This month's Art Box is written by Susi Kirkwood and Rob Harris, two of the original founders of Red Mud Arts.






