

#### From The Rectory

The Lord is near. Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus. (Philippians 4:5-7)

uttered those words this week, today even. There seems to be increasing levels of uncertainty around us and with that increasing levels of worry and anxiety. Worry is "to feel anxious or troubled about actual or potential problems." (Oxford Languages) It is being troubled about how we are going to cope with the things which life throws at us. Life is uncontrollable and we struggle with that — we are anxious. St. Paul wrote the words quoted above from the Bible book of Philippians. In it he tells us that God longs for our hearts and minds to be filled with his peace. Here, the peace of God is to have our minds at peaceful rest

"I worried about..." I wonder how many times we've

the peace of God is to have our minds at peaceful rest because we are in God's perfect hands of care. This kind of peace is mind-blowing – it *transcends all understanding*. And it guards our *hearts and [our] minds in Christ Jesus*. Protecting us from worry and anxiety.

And where does this come from – there is a little phrase just before Paul says 'Do not be anxious about anything..." "The Lord is near." You have nothing to fear, nothing to worry about because The Lord, God himself, is by your side through all your life – all the ups and downs. God is in control, so we don't have to be in control. We can trust him for our ultimate future.

That's what Paul holds on to as he writes this letter – he is in prison for his faith, on trial for his life. But he does not face it alone. God sits in the prison and God sits in the dock with him. Wherever you are – in the classroom, in the workplace, in the home, wherever... by faith in Jesus we can have God right there with us. And he promises to bring us through all we face to his heavenly home.

Paul tells us what that trust in God looks like practically – prayer. He uses four different words to describe us coming to God in prayer. Through Jesus we can enter God's presence and speak to him in prayer. Not just with a list of petitions and requests, but also just being with God, growing in that sense that he is there, he is in control, we don't need to be in control, we don't need to

worry.

#### Try Praying

If you'd like to explore the peace we can have through prayer to God, why not check

**try**praying

out 'Try Praying'. These are little booklets available free online (<a href="mailto:trypraying.org/try-it">trypraying.org/try-it</a>) or as paper booklets from our churches. Try Praying is simply a seven day practical introduction to prayer and how it can change your life. It is aimed at anyone – whether you've tried praying before or not. Why not try praying?



With reference mainly to Devon, the talk will introduce the concept of Perceptual History, of how a place has been viewed over time. He has represented the UK on the European Landscape Convention, and is now Visiting Professor of Cultural Landscapes at Bournemouth University.






