Background

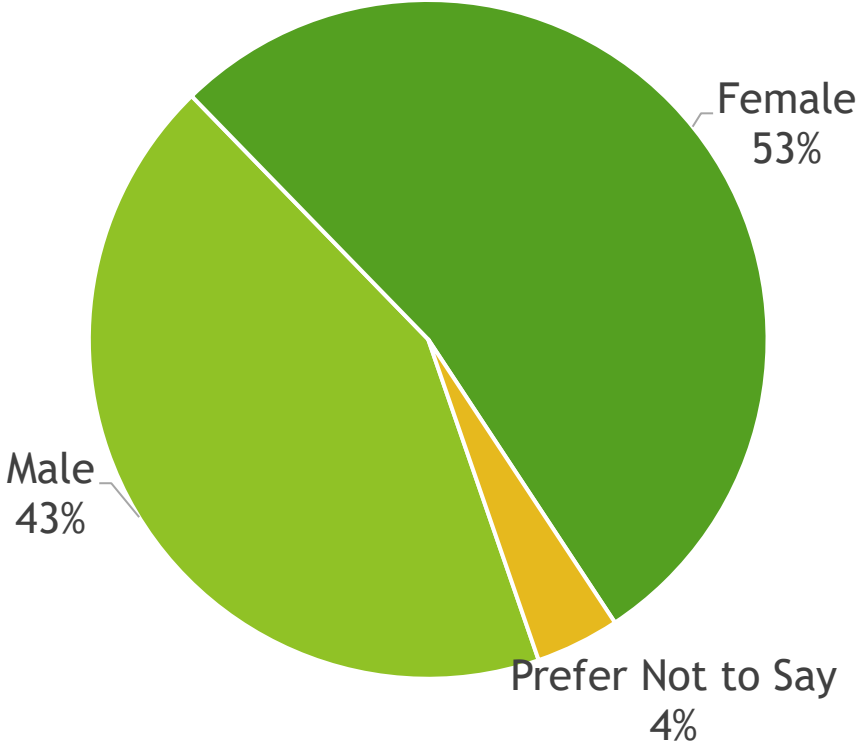
- ▶ Last Parish Survey completed in 2019
- ▶ Since then, we have had:
 - ▶ The pandemic
 - ▶ A new roof on the Village Hall and massively increased usage
 - ▶ The Prayer Book Rebellion celebrations
 - ▶ The reopening of the Dartmoor Line
 - ▶ Almost 100% turnover in Parish Council membership
 - ▶ Continuing need to maintain infrastructure in good condition (Village Green, Public Toilets etc.)

Who responded?

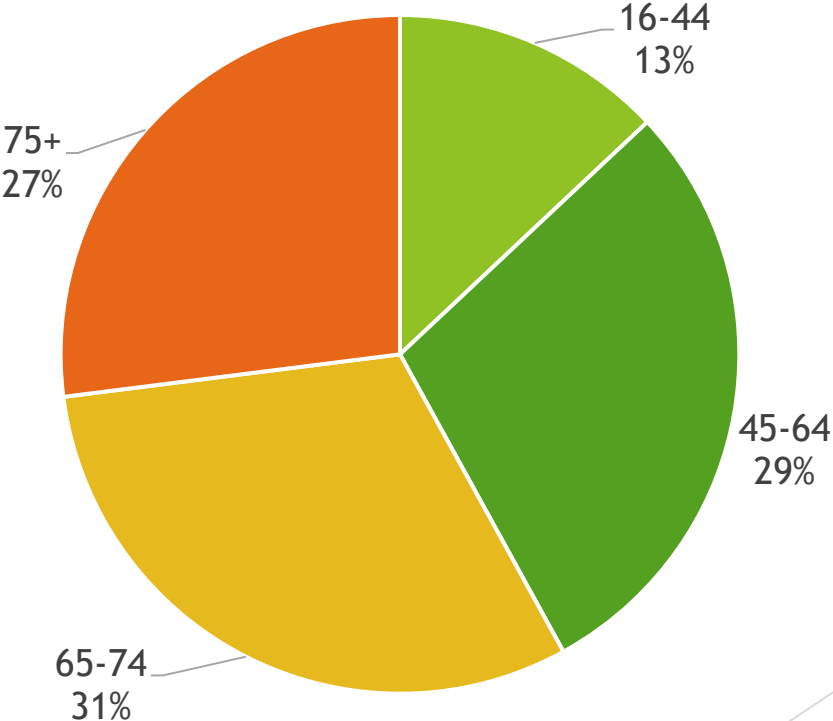
- ▶ 168 completions (vs. 81 in 2019)
 - ▶ 33% of registered electors
- ▶ Good spread of responses
 - ▶ Demographically (age, gender)
 - ▶ Within/outside the main village
 - ▶ Amongst active and less active users of community resources
- ▶ Plenty of 'engaged' respondents
 - ▶ 83/168 - 49% of respondents added comments to their questionnaires

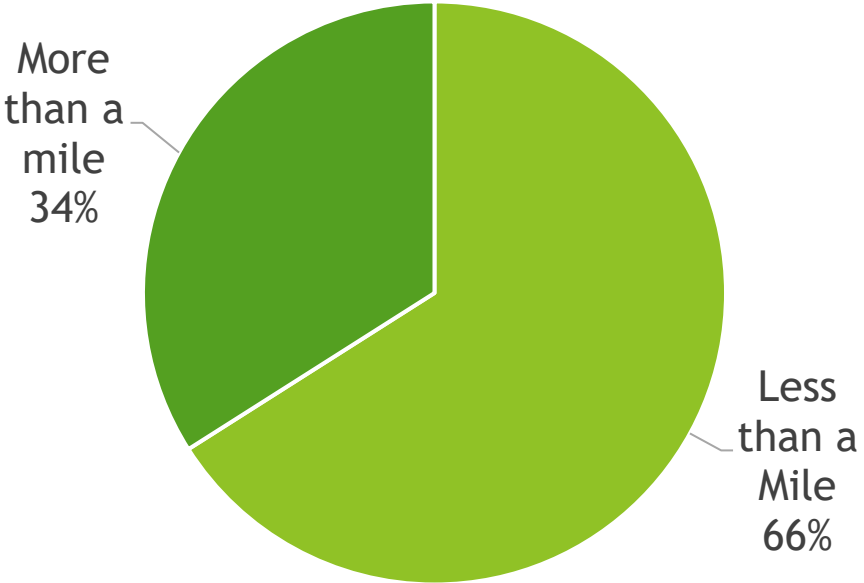

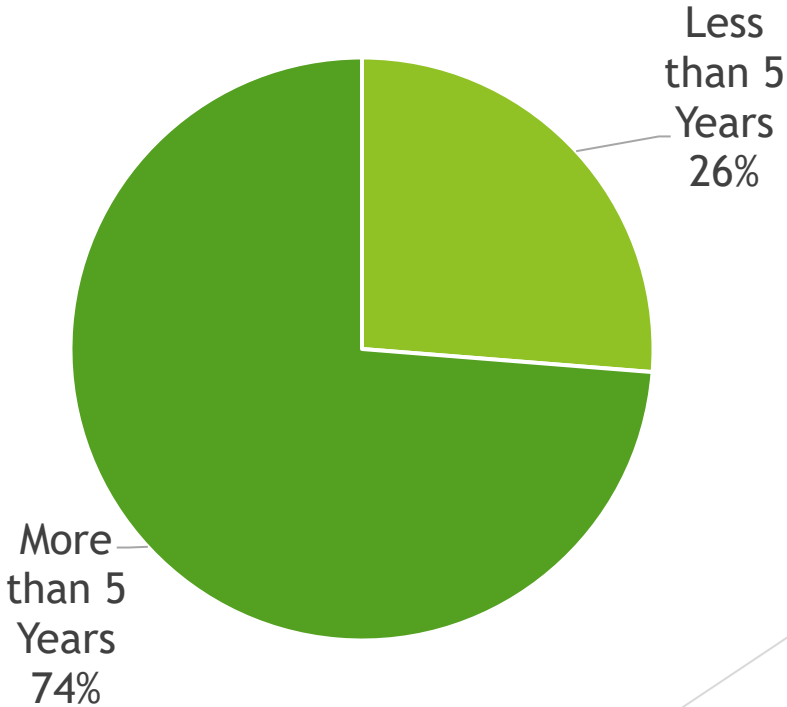


Distance from village/length of time in parish

Distance from New Inn

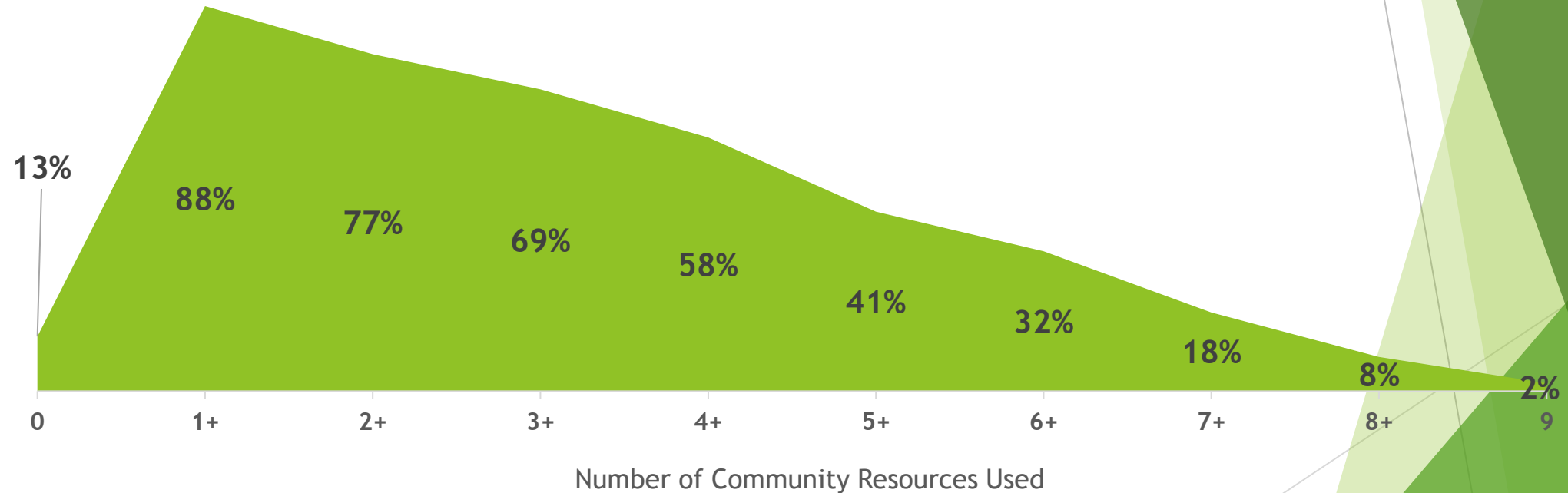


Length of Time in the Parish



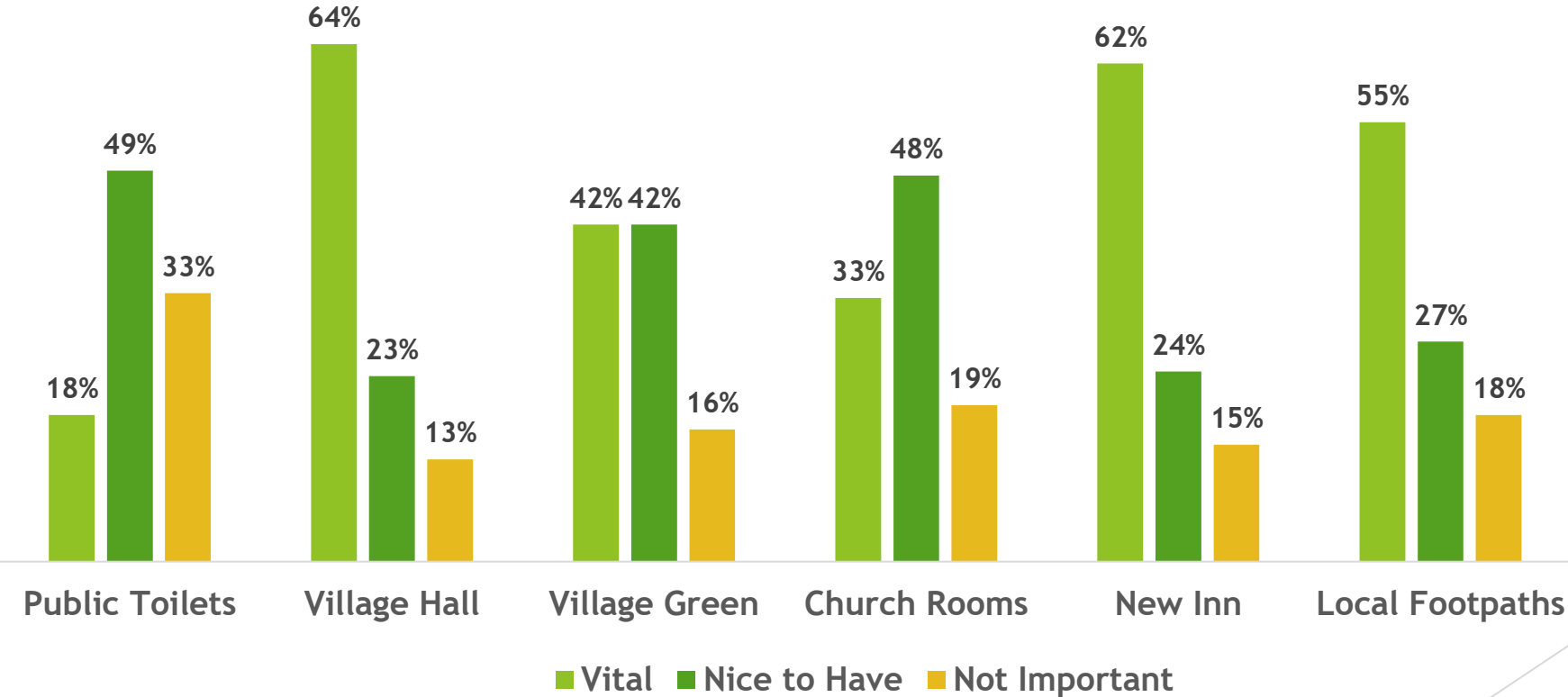
Usage of community resources

Number of People Using Community Resources* 'Often' or 'Sometimes'

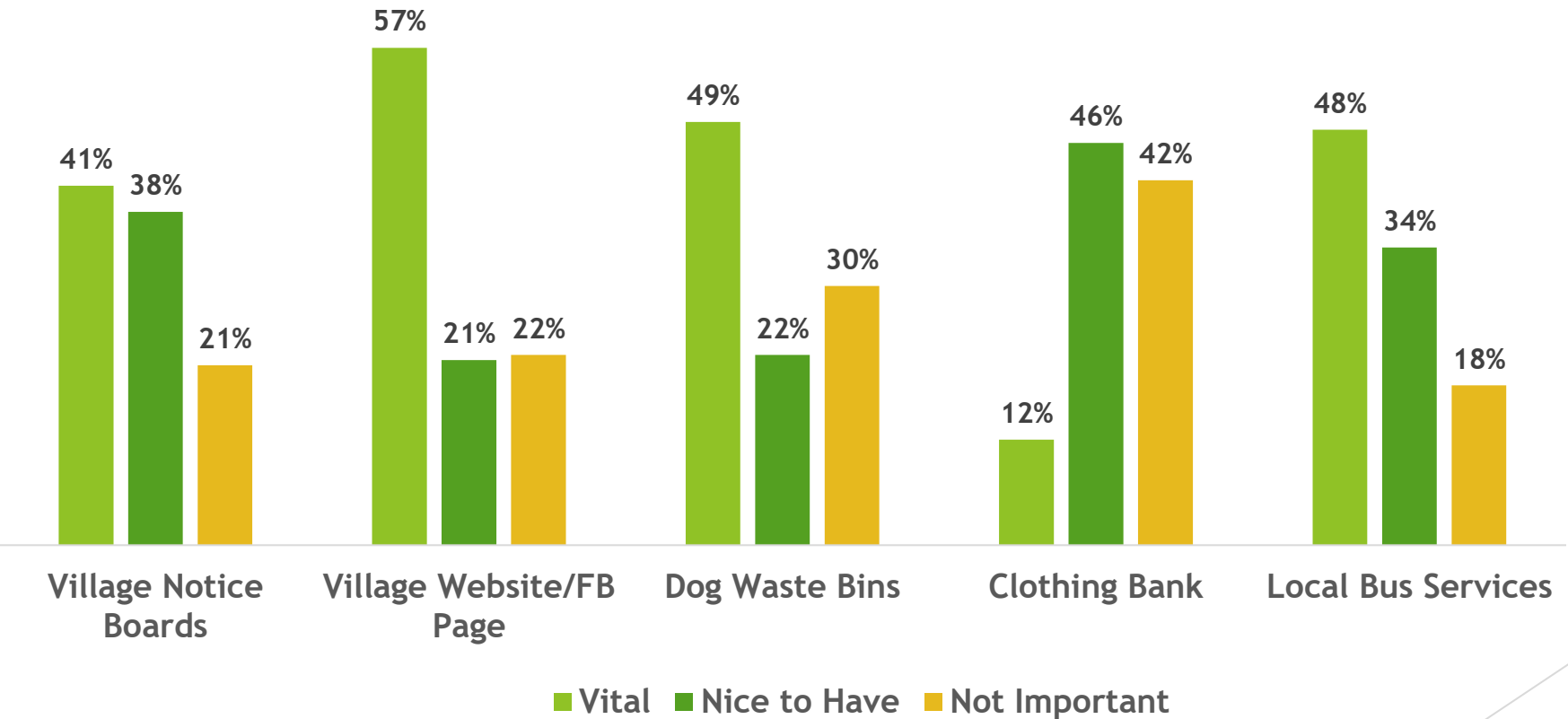

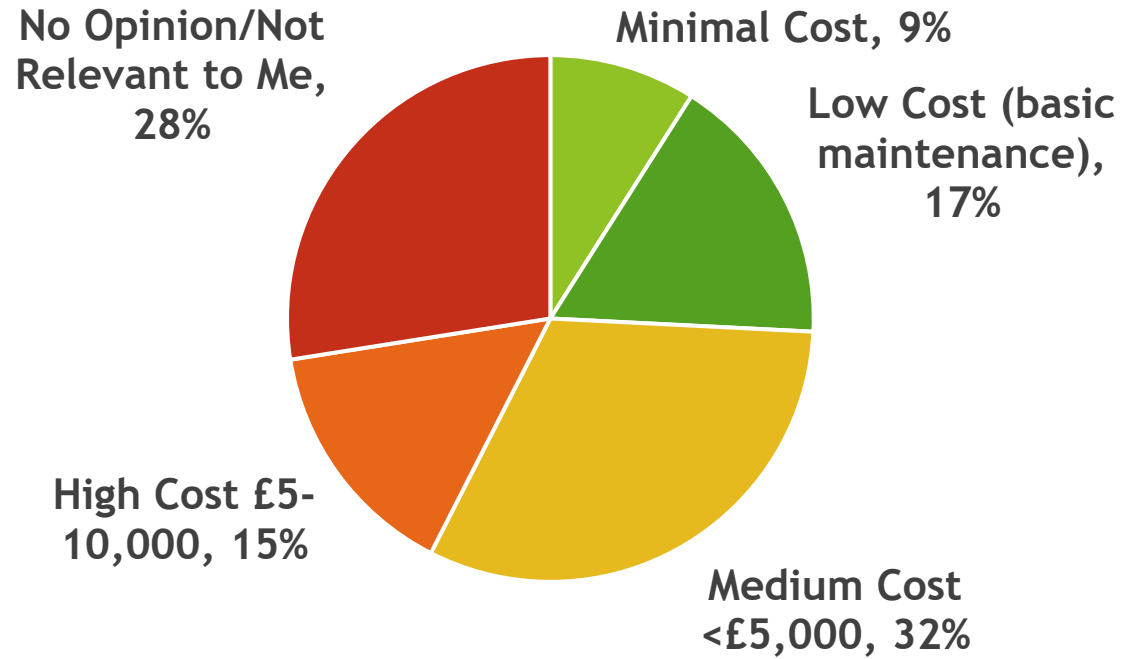
Importance of Community Resources (1)



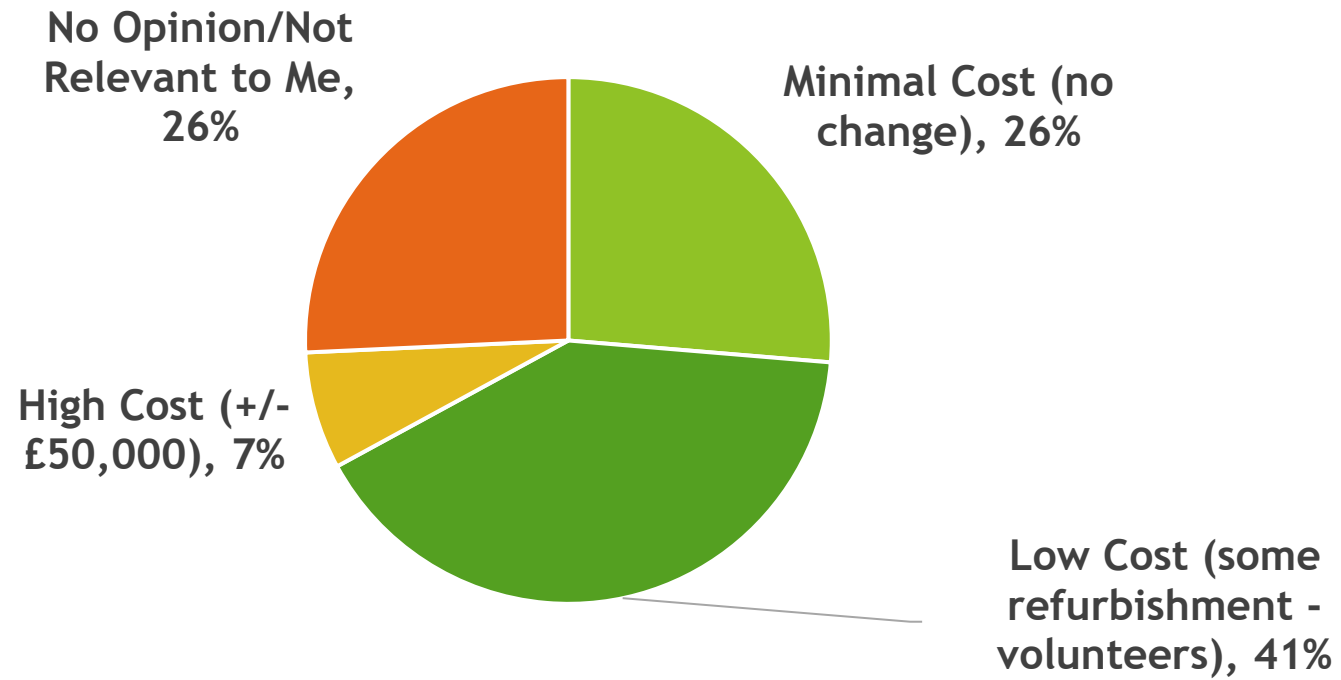
Importance of Community Resources (2)



Village green: options for development

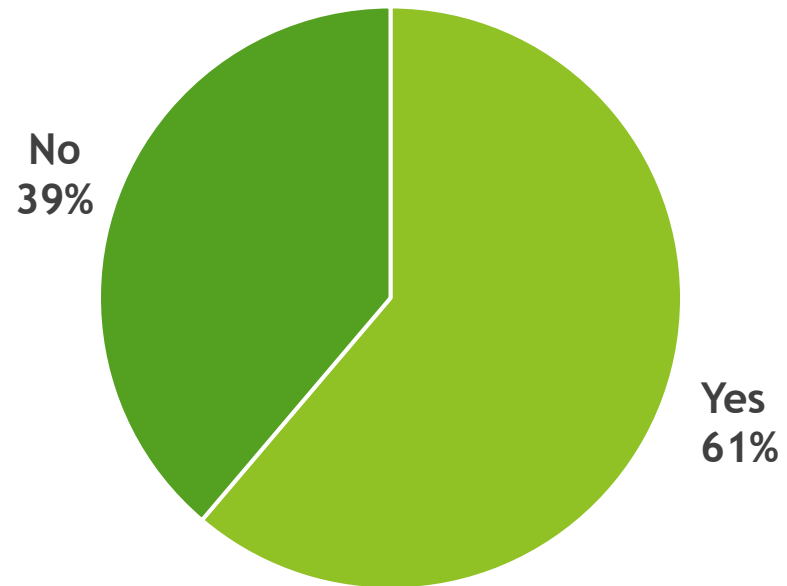
