# **From The Rectory**

It's hard to concentrate on writing an article when the snow is falling outside. My eyes keep on being drawn back to the beauty of the falling snowflakes. Like the flames of a fire I find it fascinating and could stare for hours. January and February can be quite a dull time of year – a snowfall brings a bit of excitement – the schools are to close early just the day after they open. But by the time you read this you will have already enjoyed (if that's the right word!) the so-called most depressing day of the year. It's just that time of year – dark, cold and wet.

What an invitation to bring all that we face – even those dark winter days – to God in prayer. We can come to God with confidence – he wants to offer us mercy and help when we are in times of need. But there's even more. The writer is reassuring us, that when we fail, makes mistakes, do wrong things, we can turn to him. And he doesn't shout down from heaven in judgement.

I am not sure what the equivalent to the long dark nights of winter was in Jesus's time and place, but I am sure there were similar seasons. Now, after Christmas is over and it is a long wait until the summer comes to warms our skin, is maybe when we most need to remember the truth behind what happened the first Christmas. God came to earth as the baby Jesus – and this means he...

...understands our weaknesses, for he faced all of the same testings we do, yet he did not sin. So let us come boldly to the throne of our gracious God. There we will receive his mercy, and we will find grace to help us when we need it most. (Hebrews 4:15-16)

So that he would know what it was to be one of us and even more so he could help and rescue us. As you begin 2025 why not try what the writer to the Hebrews suggests – approach the throne of this God in prayer and ask him for help in your time of need.



# Ramblings of a North Tawton W.I. Member

The Parish Council was busy in the final weeks of 2024. The Sampford Courtenay Open Parish meeting in late November was supported with administration and chaired by Cllr Wilson. The meeting was well attended and seven local speakers talked through current and planned village initiatives and community projects. A useful group discussion, table by table, formed part of the evening and a summary of the feedback and ideas have since been posted up on the website and on the local notice boards. Email the Parish Clerk on clerkscpc@gmail.com or come along to any Parish Council meeting. Our next meeting is on Wednesday March 26th 2025 at & pm in the Village Hall.

The last Parish Council meeting of 2024, also in November had a full agenda that considered 5 planning applications, 6 Parish priority updates and 3 reports on topics ranging from the possibility of a gov.uk email domain change for the council to the central government's intention to legislate remote attendance at local authority meetings in future. The council also voted to host the Sampford Courtenay christmas tree lighting and carols event with refreshments – this was subsequently enjoyed by many in the community last month.

Our Parish priority work continues to be updated and reported upon by our hardworking Councillors. Cllrs Carpenter and Green are working on some of the ideas submitted to the parish survey regarding the development of the VillageGreen. The work involved on the accessibility improvements to the Green and the Waterpath are currently out for quotes and will be reported to an early 2025 meeting.

The January 2025 meeting will have been held by the time this edition of Roundabout is printed. 



Our Ranger and Garden teams are busy working their way through all the storm damage so please look out for various path diversions as they clear fallen trees and broken branches.

I'd like to say a huge thank you to all the choirs, groups and performers who helped to create a beautiful Christmas at Castle Drogo. There were many lovely musical performances which visitors really enjoyed and a gorgeous display of handmade tulips, created by members of Dartmoor Creative Textiles, down the main stairs, recreating the tulips the Drewe family always had for Christmas. It was wonderful to see many people venture out between Christmas and new year too. A special thank you to the staff and volunteers who came in to make it possible for us to open the castle.

We now focus on the year ahead as the National Trust marks 130 years since it was founded by 3 incredible volunteers. On Dartmoor, Spring is firmly on its way with buds and bulbs appearing everywhere. Here are a few dates for your diary so you know when various places are open:

- Parke, just outside Bovey Tracey, is open from dawn until dusk all year round if you need some fresh air and a stroll through the woodland and riverside paths.
- Lydford Gorge will open both the Devil's Cauldron and Waterfall trails, 7 days a week, from Saturday 1 March, 10am 4.40pm. Always check the website in case of high winds!
- Finch Foundry opens Wednesday to Sunday from Wednesday 19 March, 11am 4pm.
- The Teign Valley estate and Fingle Woods are open every day from dawn until dusk.

  Castle Drogo partially re-opens on Monday 3 February, 10am 4pm, with the café, shop, garden and part of the castle. We then fully re-open on Monday 24 March, 10am 5pm, with new displays to mark 50 years since the National Trust opened Drogo to the public.

This leads me nicely to a very important date for your diary. On Friday 28 March, it will be exactly 50 years to the day since the Trust first opened Drogo in 1975. We would like to say a massive thank you to all of our neighbours and local communities for all of the support you have given us over those 50 years. You have been patient and kind on busy days when visitors park in funny places or get lost, and helped us to care for Drogo by visiting, bringing friends and family with you, buying a cuppa in the café, making a purchase in the shop, or donating books for the second hand bookshop.

As a sign of our appreciation, we would like to invite you for a community free entry day on Friday 28 March. Castle Drogo will be open from 10am until 5pm. Just bring along a copy of this magazine to get your free entry. Many of us will be in 1970s dress if you fancy dressing up too. Not compulsory of course! It would be fun though so dust off those flares, put on your platform shoes and join us for a brief travel back in time to 1975.

# **BONDLEIGH RAINFALL**

Firstly, I will deal with the November and December rainfall. Both months were significantly drier than the equivalent months in 2023. November measured 123.9mm compared to 168.7mm last year and December measured only 77.7mm compared to 156.5mm in 2023. Almost all of November's rain fell in the second half of the month, whereas December's was spread evenly through the month.

Total rainfall for 2024 was 1171.5 mm. (46.12ins). The wettest month was February with 196.9 mm. and the driest was June with only 19.3 mm.. This total was very similar to 2023 with 1190.4 mm (46.86ins). The wettest month being November with 168.7 mm and the driest February with 17.5 mm..

Many people ask if I have noticed any significant changes in rainfall patterns with the onset of 'climate change'. I have to admit that I have seen no change to the rainfall patterns. Our rainfall is just very variable no matter what the season. This can be shown by the last two February's.

My records start in 1996. So far, the wettest year was 2012 with 1380 mm. and the driest was 2003 with 680.9 mm.. The average over 29 years is 1032.6mm.. In the last 10 years 6 years have been above average. Perhaps a pattern is starting to emerge.

Over 50 mm. has fallen in the first 5 days of 2025. Watch this space!

Children's Mental Health Week - Know Yourself, Grow Yourself

Over the years, people have become more aware of the need to acknowledge the importance of positive attitudes towards mental health.

I am of the generation of being told 'big boys don't cry, pull yourself together and cheer up love, it might never happen.' I was led to understand that emotions were 'good or bad' and 'bad' ones should be bottled up.

As society has become more emotionally literate, we know that these attitudes have not been helpful for adults or children navigating the challenges of life. In my teaching career, educators have become increasing aware of the need to explicitly talk about managing feelings and emotions and teach children strategies for developing positive mental health.

Place2Be launched the first-ever Children's Mental Health Week in 2015 to empower, equip and give a voice to every child in the UK. It has since become a well recognised event, with hundreds of schools and colleges participating across the UK (and beyond!) as well as hundreds of children, parents and carers.

Children's Mental Health Week 2025 will take place from 3-9th February 2025.

The theme for 2025 is focus is Know Yourself, Grow Yourself, with the aim to equip and empower children and young people across the UK to embrace self-awareness and explore what it means to them. We want children and young people to discover how getting to know who they are can help them build resilience, grow and develop.

Talk about how you feel.

There are lots of helpful networks online including Place2be, NHS, NSPCC and Young Minds if you want advice to support a young person with their mental health.

Artist Matthew Jones at Ruth Smith Gallery – written by Ruth

2025 has been kicked off here by Texas-based artist, Matthew Jones, who has been staying at Ruth Smith Gallery for an art residency, with his wife, Ashley. Matthew has been making works in response to hikes around Dartmoor and trips to the coast. It's pretty staggering how much work he has produced even in the one week since arriving, easily 10 paintings and 8 sketches already, only one and a half weeks in. That's pretty impressive given the labour-intensive technique he employs- Matthew works in encaustic, which involves painting in molten beeswax mixed with pigment, which cools quickly on application. He's also been incorporating moss which adds to the already extremely textured surface of the paintings. Matthew has been working on top of card he has made out of old mount board and moss that he has soaked, turned into a pulp and then pressed to make a beautiful grey-brown and very textured paper. The charcoal and chalk drawings show it off at its best. An exhibition is planned for Matthew's last couple of days here, with a late opening on the last night to celebrate his time on the residency, and today he gave a workshop on his methods to 6 or 7 of us North Tawtonians. Due to needing to travel light, Matthew ordered his equipment directly to the gallery and intends to leave much of it here. We hope to make it available through the Library of Things, so that others can try their hand at this really interesting technique!
