From The Rectory

Welcome to the Summer! As I write this, we are having scorching weather and the normal string of summer term events are underway – summer fayres, sports days, open gardens and pantos. I really hope it's still great weather once the children are off.

Over the summer many of us head off on trips away. I've been overhearing people talking about some great summer holiday plans in the playground and in church. Still others are off on trips even further afield, particularly seeing family and friends in far flung places. Others of us are just hoping to enjoy a glorious Devon summer as we continue working as normal. I wonder what you are up to this summer.

Recently in a church service we were considering the journey which the Old Testament hero, Abraham, made. While today we have a host of resources at our disposal to plan our trips – both traditional: maps, guidebooks and travel writing; and also modern: street view, trip advisor and a plethora of blogs – poor Abraham didn't have anything. No maps. No road signs. Not even roads! Later in the Bible, Abraham's choice to go is put starkly: By faith Abraham, when called to go to a place he would later receive as his inheritance,

obeyed and went, even though he did not know where he was going. (Hebrews 11:8)

A journey without motorised transport of over 2000km, totally into the unknown. No clue as to where you're

going. God basically said – leave it all behind, family, friends and nation – and follow me.

I don't know about you, but I find this a great metaphor of our lives – an adventure into the unknown, one where we don't know where it will lead. The summer holiday is often a time when we make that step into the unknown new school, colleges and universities for many young people – but it is also often the time where families move to new homes, areas and jobs too. For Abraham, God took him on an amazing adventure – he had an amazing time, won battles, travelled widely, gained great wealth and met with God. And his legacy lived on: in the Jewish people descended from him, in the Jewish, Christian and Muslim faiths which all look to him as a founding father. And supremely for Christians in Jesus Christ his great son who was also God's Son come to rescue the world! That's quite an adventure and it all started by trusting in God and taking a step into the unknown! For us on our own journeys (real and metaphorical) Abraham's story teaches us that God wants to make that journey with us if we welcome him along. And that's a great idea as he knows where we are heading, even if we don't. He wants to go with us as we journey into the unknown, through all the highs and lows, joys and disappointments. Who knows where the adventure with





God might lead!



Ever wondered what goes on behind the doors of the Town Council Office? Our day begins bright and early with a flood of emails – anywhere between 70-90 emails for the Town Clerk and Deputy Clerk, and more on a Monday! The messages cover anything from local concerns on road closures, flooding, potholes, fly-tipping, and other queries on logistical requests and information regarding relevant authorities. No day is the same and has a fast paced, varied ever-changing inbox.

Our responsibilities extend further – managing the cemetery and coordinating burials with care and compassion, updating and safeguarding council records, overseeing the town's public spaces, including the public conveniences and the clock. We are currently working on an exciting upgrade to the play equipment in the park, while also managing the other assets of open spaces. With managing the Town's financial records, council accounts, responding to residents' questions and offering support and help, we are a first point of contact for many, and always strive to provide the best service we can. An awareness of life outside the office helps us to report and monitor infrastructure issues, and each month we prepare legally required Agendas and Minutes, from which the backbone of democratic decision making in North Tawton ensures the Town continues to run smoothly.

From our office here at the Town Council we observe a lot of North Tawton life. The comings and goings of people going about their daily business, dog walkers, delivery drivers, buses, the odd lorry, and postal vans. In recent weeks we have been really saddened to see the closure of Jen's Café. Many of you will know Jen Marvin, who has run the café since early 2018. The café has been a hub for the community, and a place to meet friends, share lunch, or to just go and be somewhere warm and inviting in the colder months. Jen has always offered a huge amount of support to people, particularly during the Covid Lockdown's of 2020 by always making sure people have food and friendship. Jen has often been a listening ear, a friend to hug and welcomed all who went into her little café, both locals and tourists, with open arms. The café will be missed, and we wish Jen and her family all the best for the future.

Don't forget, if you have ever wondered what your local Council does, or how decisions are made that impact on your daily life here in the town, we warmly invite you to visit us. Whether is it stopping by the Office, using our book swap, attending a Council meeting, or the monthly Councillor Surgery, you are always welcome. Councillor Surgeries run on the second Saturday of the month from 10 a.m. - 12.30.p.m., where you can meet your local Councillors in person and have face to face advice, chats, and discussions. If we can't help directly, we will know who can.

Office opening hours are Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday, 10.30-12.30. We are at the office outside these hours but aren't open to the public unless at the specified times.

Ramblings of a North Tawton W.I. Member

Every year he says it. Just before the tickets go on sale. Every year. 'Are we going to Glasto?' The question is met with a look. A look that needs no words to explain the answer – as it's the same answer every year. No. We are not going to Glasto. You don't like crowds. Along the way he has written four children's books with co-author, Falklands War Veteran and best friend Simon Weston CBE – Fitz has also written for Spitting Image and has even made an appearance in a Trivial Pursuit question. So has he retired? He's too busy to retire. He is much in demand as an MC and compere – entertaining many with his after dinner talks filled with stories and anecdotes. He writes regularly for the North Devon Gazette and The Moorlander and hosts a podcast called 'Fitz in the Community' which focuses on stories and conversations with and about Devon's people plus he is a great supporter of military charities and those involved with dementia. Difficult to imagine him ever really retiring – oh, and he always wears odd socks.

Fitz continued to entertain us whilst staying for the business bit of the meeting and was particularly interested in the idea of our North Tawton W.I. It was also encouraging to identify that the 'No Mow May' initiative identified 5 naturally seeded wild flowers on the small patch of ground at Red Post.

The Next meeting is to take place on Wednesday 3rd September 2025 at the Village Hall. Everyone is welcome and if you would like to raise an item for the Agenda, please let the Clerk know in advance.

The first year, last year, was a successful year but we would like this one to be even better!! We hope to see you all there.



NORTH TAWTON SCOUTS NEED YOUR HELP -NEW LEADERS REQUIRED

Being the 1st, North Tawton Group Scout Leader, I need to put an urgent request out for help to the local community. Since the early 1900's 1st North Tawton Scout Group have been a thriving part of the local community with our smart uniforms and blue/white neckers being proudly worn by our young persons for all to see. During our history there have been some times when scouting in North Tawton stopped due to external issues, during the war and in more recent times due to COVID for example, but also several periods when Scouting stopped locally due to a lack of adults volunteering to be become leaders. Unfortunately we are now approaching the same scenario. We have been very lucky to have had a dedicated and stable leader team for many years, but for personal and work reasons several of the current leaders have reduced their availability to support the group. This means that although we will be issuing a full scout programme for the coming terms, including camps for next year, there is a high probability that without new leaders we will need to cancel meetings at short notice or even close the scout section completely later in the year. This is the reality of the situation we are facing; the closure of the Scout section would result in the 15 Scouts we already have being unable to continue their Scouting Journey and will have knock on effects to the Cubs, Beavers and Squirrel Scouts who will be unable to move up through all the sections. If you think you can help us, know of a family member, or friend who would like to become a scout leader, then please talk to us urgently. Being a scout leader is great fun and doesn't need any particular skills to start. If you are interested in helping scouts to have fun and develop their personal and practical skills, then being a leader could be for you and is massively rewarding. The time commitment is not excessive; meetings taking up a couple of hours a week on a Wednesday evening with a small amount of preparation time depending on the activities and your current skill level. Please remember that we are only teaching the scouts the basics of most subjects, so you don't need to be experts in anything and it is easy for you to stay one step ahead of them with a bit of help from ourselves. In addition, in order to ensure we operate safely for both the scouts and yourselves, there is some training you must complete with the scout association. The mandatory training on safety and child protection consists of a few online courses that must be completed over the first few months and will take a few hours in manageable chunks. Further training is available and can be taken at a more leisurely pace as a mix of face to face and online training. Whilst scouting does not insist on having female leaders in the section as we have almost 50% of female scouts, we would very much like to be fully representative in the leader team, so this request is equally applicable to all parents, carers, family members and friends. 



HOW ARE YOUR POTATOES IN A BUCKET DOING?

There are still a few weeks to go before you need to bring your bucket up to the Village Hall for weighing to see just how many potatoes can be grown from one seed potato.

If growing potatoes is new to you check out some advice from RHS here https://www.rhs.org.uk/vegetables/potatoes/grow-your-own

And keep an eye out for BLIGHT - once your potatoes have flowered the tops should be cut off after the foliage has died back, typically when the leaves turn yellow and wilt, to encourage the tubers to mature and develop a good skin set. Then leave them in the bucket until JUDGING DAY!


