

# From The Rectory

It's September once again, the start of another school year – the end of the school holidays after six weeks. For those with children everything changes – new shoes, new schools and perhaps a hint of relief. Even if we don't have children or grandchildren around, there is still plenty of fun to occupy us in the summer months – holidays away, festivals, shows, open gardens, concerts ... the summer is the season of fun. And now we all must buckle down for the long four-month haul to Christmas and the next pause in the frantic work schedule. The nights are getting longer, the weather getting colder and wetter. Autumn is here.

This autumn as a family we are facing another level of busyness as we will have four children at four different schools. This is only likely to add to the shock of the September return to school! Modern life, in general, seems to give us more and more balls to juggle and more things to be anxious about.

Jesus gave some quick fire advice about worry once when he was teaching. He began:

I tell you, do not worry about your life, what you will eat or drink; or about your body, what you will wear. (Matthew 6:25)

Jesus was speaking largely to a very poor, oppressed community for whom worries about where the next meal would come from or whether they would have clothes to dress in were real. Jesus is saying to them – not so much 'don't worry or else' which would be very harsh, but instead 'dear children, you don't need to worry because God is your loving Father in heaven'. He goes on to say that God provides food for the birds even though they don't worry or plan. And of course he cares for you even more! He tells us that ultimately worrying is a fruitless waste of energy:

Can any one of you by worrying add a single hour to your life? (Matthew 6:27)

And he suggests we keep our horizons short so that we are not overwhelmed with all that needs to be done:

Therefore do not worry about tomorrow, for tomorrow will worry about itself. Each day has enough trouble of its own. (Matthew 6:34)

But ultimately, Jesus' solution to worry is to keep seeking our Father God, keep trusting him, keep working for him and trust him for the rest:

... your heavenly Father knows that you need [all these things]. But seek first his kingdom and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well. (Matthew 6:32-33)

So, I've been told! I'm going to enjoy the blessings of the holiday now and not worry about September. And I am going to seek God and trust him for the rest.

What's Happening at North Tawton Town Council?

A lot has been happening here at North Tawton Town Council. In recent weeks we have been able to install new bins, there are new notice boards at the bus stop by the Rugby Club down by the bridge, and in Strawberry Fields, with more on the way. We also have new benches, the first two have replaced old ones, and the third was kindly donated to us for the Memorial Park.

We would also like to welcome out newly appointed Councillor, Mr. Jay Scrutton, who many in North Tawton will know well from his days at the Pistachio Tree. Jay has said that he will bring a fresh pair of eyes, a range of, and lots of, experience to the role. We look forward to working with him. There are two spaces on the Town Council, and if you feel like joining us too, please be in touch on the details below.

The next Councillor Surgery is to be on the 13<sup>th</sup> September 2025, at the Town Council Office, between 10 a.m.-12 noon. This is an opportunity for members of the public to come and meet Councillors, ask questions, discuss issues, ask for advice, or just to chat and get to know the Councillors better. Our Councillors have all noted that they have enjoyed their time working at the Surgeries and have been pleased to meet so many people through their sessions.

At the Full Council Meeting on the 5<sup>th</sup> August 2025, the Councillors agreed to reinstate the Public Participation at Council meetings. While the Council has no legal obligation to have public participation, it was felt that this can be a useful and positive experience when conducted in the right way. Therefore, this will now be in accordance with the new Public Participation Policy we have adopted to ensure the smooth running of the public period. Alongside this, there is to be a three-month trial run of public participation, starting at next meeting on the 2<sup>nd</sup> September, and this will then be reviewed after the three-month trial in November.

Another way in which we connect and support our community here in North Tawton, is via The Durant Trust. This was established following the Will of John Glendon Durant, who passed away on the 22<sup>nd</sup> January, 1947. His Will stated: "Trust Fund in Trust for the Parish Council of North Tawton in the County of Devon absolutely to be applied by the said Parish Council for the benefit of the inhabitants of the Parish of North Tawton"

This Charitable fund is designed to provide grants to organisations within our community, with a focus on community projects, and to support local businesses. Grants are designed to fund general charitable purposes, amateur sport, environmental, conservation and heritage concerns, and recreational activities. Organisations within North Tawton may apply for funding at any time and shall do so on a simple form provided by the Charity for that purpose. Application forms can be sent together with any supporting documents relating to the organisation's finances and the purpose of the funds requested, to North Tawton Town Council for The Durant Trust to consider.

If you are part of a local organisation, business or charity, and haven't already done so, consider applying for a grant from The Durant Trust. # Ramblings of a North Tawton W.I. Member

As predictably as Tuesday follows Monday husband will ask, at some point during the day, 'what's for tea?' Sometimes I dread the question, knowing that I'm going to have to transform beans on toast into something worthy of a Michelin star – (hot tip – a handful of grated tasty cheese and a glug of Worcestershire sauce work wonders) sometimes I smile smugly knowing that in the fridge lurk leftovers from yesterday that just need to be reheated to an acceptable temperature and smothered in gravy. Luckily (for me) husband is easily pleased when it comes to what's on the menu. He will eat pretty much anything. So I was flicking through a food magazine recently, looking for inspiration, and I thought that next time he asks me 'what's for tea?', I might just say – 'tonight, husband, we are going to have aubergine and barberry kuku followed by bolo de arroz'. Here you'll find a complete set of daily weather summaries detailing the weather for every day from July 1869 to the present, a fascinating collection of historic weather instruments, rare books including a 12<sup>th</sup> century illuminated manuscript and books and papers relating to significant expeditions such as Robert Scott's Terra Nova expedition to Antarctica in 1910. And so much more besides. And another good thing – the library is open to the public, just make an appointment and all that fascinating weathery information is yours to explore.

Back to food. I read an interesting article recently about coffee. Now, I hesitate to go into too much detail but for those who are able to do the Google thingy just look up Kopi Luwak. For those who do not do the Google thingy please read on. It would appear to be the most expensive and exclusive coffee on the planet. It has a very unusual method of production. It is made from coffee beans which have been eaten and partially digested by a cat. But not just any cat. Oh no. These coffee beans have been eaten and partially digested by the Indonesian palm civet. And I shall let you decide what the inevitable consequences of eating something and partially digesting it are. Spying on somebody's spuds. Casting furtive glances over someone's carrots and cabbages. The rural equivalent of a Bond Girl.





# NORTH TAWTON SCOUTS NEED YOUR HELP -NEW LEADERS REQUIRED

Being the 1<sup>st</sup>, North Tawton Group Scout Leader, I need to put an urgent request out for help to the local community. Since the early 1900's 1<sup>st</sup> North Tawton Scout Group has been a thriving part of the local community with our smart uniforms and blue/white neckers being proudly worn by our young persons for all to see. During our history there have been some times when scouting in North Tawton stopped due to external issues, during the war and in more recent times due to COVID for example, but also several periods when Scouting stopped locally due to a lack of adults volunteering to be become leaders. Unfortunately we are now approaching the same scenario. We have been very lucky to have had a dedicated and stable leader team for many years, but for personal and work reasons several of the current leaders have reduced their availability to support the group. This means that although we will be issuing a full scout programme for the coming terms, including camps for next year, there is a high probability that without new leaders we will need to cancel meetings at short notice or even close the scout section completely later in the year. This is the reality of the situation we are facing; the closure of the Scout section would result in the 15 Scouts we already have being unable to continue their Scouting Journey and will have knock on effects to the Cubs, Beavers and Squirrel Scouts who will be unable to move up through all the sections. If you think you can help us, know of a family member, or friend who would like to become a scout leader, then please talk to us urgently. Being a scout leader is great fun and doesn't need any particular skills to start. If you are interested in helping scouts to have fun and develop their personal and practical skills, then being a leader could be for you and is massively rewarding. The time commitment is not excessive; meetings taking up a couple of hours a week on a Wednesday evening with a small amount of preparation time depending on the activities and your current skill level. Please remember that we are only teaching the scouts the basics of most subjects, so you don't need to be experts in anything and it is easy for you to stay one step ahead of them with a bit of help from ourselves. In addition, in order to ensure we operate safely for both the scouts and yourselves, there is some training you must complete with the scout association. The mandatory training on safety and child protection consists of a few online courses that must be completed over the first few months and will take a few hours in manageable chunks. Further training is available and can be taken at a more leisurely pace as a mix of face to face and online training. Whilst scouting does not insist on having female leaders in the section as we have almost 50% of female scouts, we would very much like to be fully representative in the leader team, so this request is equally applicable to all parents, carers, family members and friends. 



# NORTH TAWTON TOWN HALL

Did you know that North Tawton Town Hall is a Registered Charity?

Are you aware that the Hall belongs to the residents of the Town?

Did you know that the Hall is used by various groups every day / evening of the week?

The Town Hall is run by a small Management Committee, many are Trustees of the Charity. Every year there is an Annual General Meeting open to all "Users" and all members of the public, but attendance is poor.

The only income is from hire charges and monthly Bingo nights. The Committee try to keep the hire charges as low as possible so that the cost of running the hall is not passed on to "Hirers" and attendees at their classes or events.

We need your support! We need Committee Members and Trustees (all Trustees are covered by our insurance) We need ideas for fundraising events! We need people!

Currently there is a desperate need to install a new heating system in the Main Hall, the previous one having been condemned and shut down – this will cost in the region of £16,000. Grants are being applied for, but if they are not forthcoming, the Main Hall will have to close once the temperature drops in the Autumn, until the new heating system is installed. This will result in the loss of revenue and immediate cancellation of events.

There are other problems which need to be dealt with as soon as possible. We need now larger guttering and

There are other problems which need to be dealt with as soon as possible. We need new larger guttering and down-pipes and rendering to the front stonework to stop water ingress. We also need more energy efficient windows throughout – being a Grade 2 Listed building and in a Conservation area means that this cost will be around £50,000.






