## From The Rectory

In the last few months, I seem to have had a few more visits to our doctors and hospitals than I normally would. Maybe it shows I'm not as quite as young as I once was! I've always found our doctors surgery here in North Tawton to be helpful and give a quick response. It makes me grateful to live in a country and an age where there is free and available healthcare.

Anyway, when I've been fit and healthy (and younger too) I have not expected to see my doctor very often. In fact, I think we'd all be hoping that our GPs were focused on helping those who were unwell and needed their help.

But when Jesus was around he had to make this point exactly. He came as a doctor for spiritual and emotional things as well as for physical ailments

too. But as a religious leader he was judged for spending time with those who were spiritually unwell, those who were wrongdoers, sinners. He had to point out how illogical that was:

“Who needs a doctor: the healthy or the sick? I'm here inviting the sin-sick, not the spiritually-fit.” (Mark 2:17)

I find this so encouraging when I trip up and get things wrong, make mistakes and even wilfully do wrong. The people that Jesus, the Son of God, is attracted to and helps are not the perfect goodie-two-shoes, but those who are sick with wrongdoing. He invites those sorts of people, those who muck it up, to come to him and find spiritual healing and forgiveness.

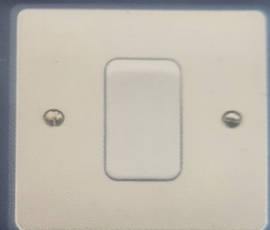

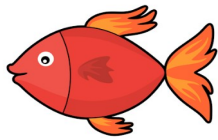

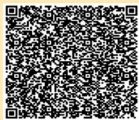

## The Cack-Handed Crafter

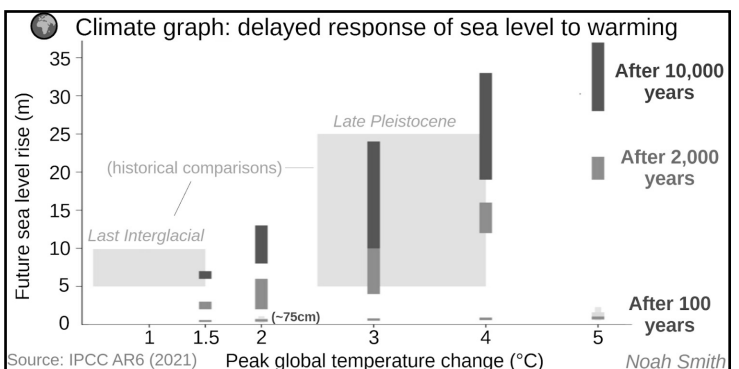

## **BONDLEIGH RAINFALL**

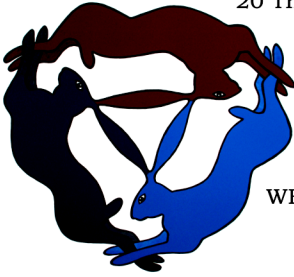

## Under the Same Sky

Under The Same Sky is a collection of photographs by Rob Harris that celebrates the richness and quiet dignity of the wildlife with whom we share this planet. Through intimate and often striking imagery, the work invites us to pause and reconsider our place within the natural world—not as observers standing apart, but as participants within a vast, interconnected system.

These photographs serve as a reminder of the extraordinary diversity of life on Earth. Each species, no matter how small or seemingly distant, plays a role in maintaining the delicate balance that sustains us all. By presenting animals not as curiosities or “others,” but as fellow inhabitants, the collection

challenges us to recognise a shared existence—one in which every life is shaped by the same environmental forces and vulnerabilities.

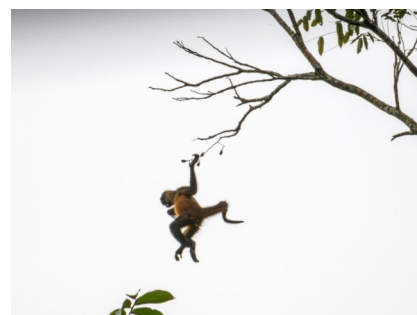
Every image captures a moment in an unfiltered world: a life lived without the buffers and protections that humans so often construct for themselves. Each creature is portrayed with its own character, resilience, and beauty, yet also with an underlying fragility. These lives unfold under constant pressure—from climate change, from shrinking habitats, from the presence of predators, and increasingly, from human encroachment.

While humanity builds walls, borders, and shelters in an attempt to control and define space, the sky above remains unchanged—an ever-present, unifying expanse that belongs equally to all living beings. It is a quiet but powerful symbol of our shared reality. Beneath it, the relationship between humans and

nature is revealed as both profound and precarious: a balance that demands awareness, respect, and care.

In essence, Under the Same Sky is both a celebration of wildlife and a gentle invitation to reflect on our shared existence with the natural world. It encourages us to look more closely, to feel more deeply, and to recognise that the fate of every species—including our own—is inseparably linked under the same sky.

### **Blooming Marvelous – the enjoyment of Spring**

This month here in the Town Council Office we have been planning how we can bring nature into the Town Square. The hanging baskets are back by popular demand, and we would like to thank Councillor Burrow and a local resident for all their hard work on arranging for the six baskets to be filled and distributed around the Square. These are in addition to the planters and displays in the town's shop windows. Over the summer months, the Town Council will also be considering a new Biodiversity Policy and Tree Policy, as part of reaching the targets we have set ourselves in the newly written Strategic Plan, which is now available on the Town Council Website.

One of our other objectives for this year is to promote the use of the Diana Memorial Garden by the bridge. This garden offers a quiet space down by the river and has benches and picnic table for summer outings and moments of quiet reflection. There have been ideas of adding some wildflowers to this garden and other sites around the town, so watch this space. Another of our objectives is to raise awareness of the historic and natural environments in the town. Most residents are aware of the number of historic buildings we have, and some of these locations appear in the Photo of the Week on our Facebook Page.

On the 30th of April we hosted the Annual Town Meeting. This was attended by Councillors and residents and proved to be a positive evening. The local First Responders gave a talk and demonstrated how important they are to the community. The Town Council will be holding a Defib training session at the Rugby Club on 3rd September at 7pm, so do come along and join us if you are interested in learning this key skill.

We also discussed the ongoing issue of parking availability in the Square and we are planning to conduct a consultation to accurately assess the needs of both residents and local businesses, with a view to finding a solution to the problems that arise. Information on this will follow in due course. Updates will be noted on the Facebook Page and Website, so do keep an eye on those. If you don't have either, then have a look at the Town Council Notice Boards around the town. We use these to notify residents of events, both Council run and otherwise, along with relevant information regarding the Town Council and its services.

Do you have concerns about speeding vehicles in North Tawton? Have you had an accident or near-miss because somebody was driving too fast? Then please consider joining our Community Speedwatch group, sponsored by the Police and we have been trained and loaned a Police-issue speed gun so we can monitor traffic speeds. We don't try to stop vehicles that are exceeding the speed limit, nor do we have the power to issue tickets. How it works relies on volunteers giving up a small amount of time to stand by the roadside and measure the speed of vehicles. The data is then passed to the Police, and the registered keeper of the vehicle gets a letter from the Police informing them of the date, time and location and reminding them of the risk they are putting other road users and pedestrians to. We know these letters work in modifying driver behaviour and if anyone is a 'repeat offender' they get a home visit from a Police Officer to give a formal warning.

Speedwatch can only work if we can get more volunteers - you only need to be able to give maybe an hour a month. We provide all necessary training and a hi-viz tabard so drivers know they are being monitored. You should have a clean driving licence although it does help if you can recognise makes and models of vehicles. Want to know more? Please contact the Town Clerk or Deputy Clerk and they will put you in touch with the Speedwatch group. You would be helping to keep our Town safe.

The Book Swap sees its first anniversary this June, and we have been so pleased to meet the residents and regular users of this service. The book swap is still going strong, and books from our collection are also available to borrow via the Repair Café. So if you also feel like bringing more nature and greenery into the town, then stop by and see whether any of the many gardening books we have will be of inspiration.

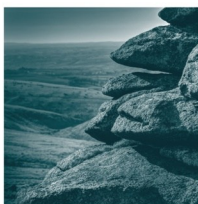
